Scholarship Winner



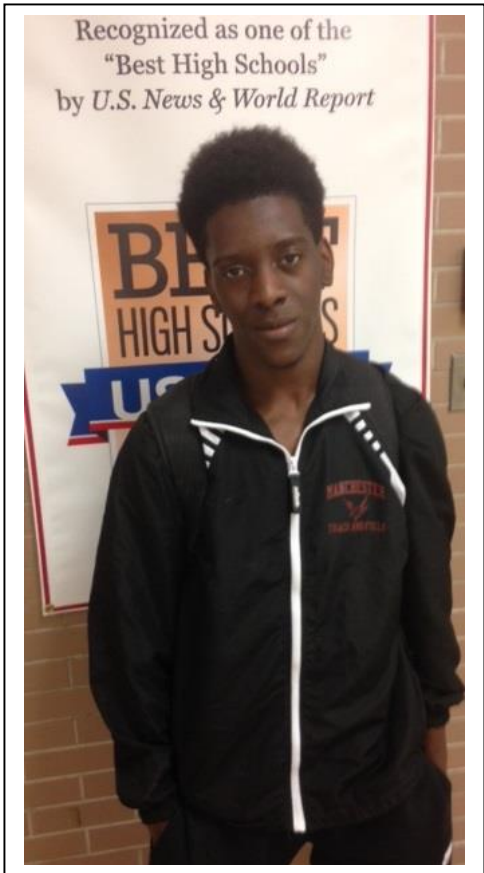

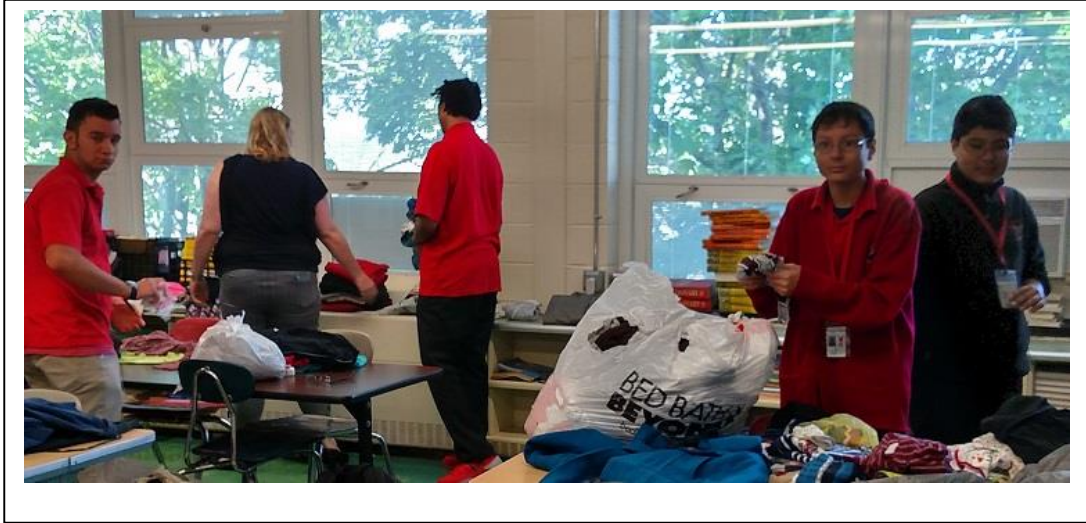
TGIF
