



Automated Phone Call Opt Out

The Telephone Consumer Protection Act ("TCPA"), is a federal law designed to protect consumers from receiving unwanted telemarketing messages in the form of automatic voice calls or texts on their cellular phone. Among its many requirements, the TCPA prohibits use of automatic telephone dialing equipment or a pre-recorded call or text to any cellular phone to provide informational content without the recipient's prior express consent.

Bryan ISD utilizes an automated phone call system to notify parents of such events as emergencies, weather delays, student absences, missing assignments, and general information and announcements about Bryan ISD and the school which the student attends.

If you DO NOT want to receive these automated phone calls on your cellular phone, then please complete and submit this Opt-Out form to your student's school.

This opt-out form applies to the current school year and must be specifically renewed at the beginning of each school year.
