- *Students, the SHS prom will be held on Sat., April 7 at 8:00 p.m. at the N at Hardway Ranch. The dress code for boys will be a tux, suit, or nice pants with a dress shirt. Guys will need to wear either dress shoes or nice boots. Shorts and/or t-shirts will not be permitted. Girls will need to wear dresses that are not overly revealing. Dresses may not be two piece and the midriff must be completely covered. Girls may also choose to wear nice pant suits as well. All other dress code rules apply (no facing jewelry, exposed tattoos, etc.) Boys will need to be clean shaven.*
 - *Also, if you are planning on bringing a date that does not attend SHS; you will need to get a form from the office. This form must be completed fully and turned in to the office by Wednesday, April 4 for an outside guest to be allowed to attend prom. This form could require signatures from school personnel from other districts. So, you need to pick one up and plan accordingly.*
