Extra! Extra! Read All About It!



- Read the directions, question and texts carefully! Reread if you are confused or if you need to find an answer.

Jail the Detail



- Highlight, underline, or circle the details in the questions!
- This helps you focus on exactly what the question is.

Slash the Trash!

- A. He keeps his promises.
- B. He is loyal to the king.
- C. He is cruel and uncaring.
- ~~D. He like to play games.~~



- Read **all** choices.
- **Eliminate** any choices that you **know** are wrong answers.
- Think carefully over the choices left
- Choose what you think is the **best** answer.

Be Slick and Predict!



I think the answer
could be

- Read the question carefully. **Predict** what the answer could be **before** you read the choices! This will help you pick the correct answer.

Be a Whiz with the Grid



- A machine grades your test. If it isn't bubbled just right . . . Yikes!! You won't get credit for your hard work.

Plug It In, Plug It In!



$$100 - ? = 40$$

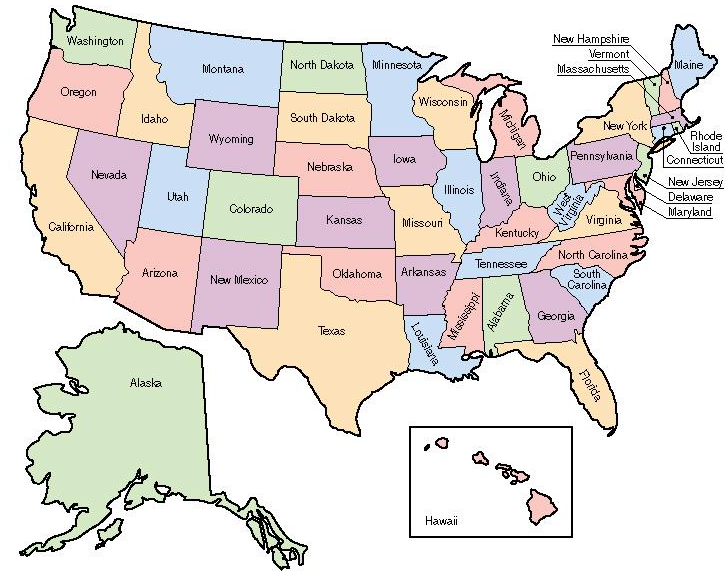
What could the answer be?
