GOAL: Creating Lifelong Learners

Action Steps:

- Ensure a safe and inviting climate for every child
- Implementation of a system of equity and access for all students
- Create a culture of productivity and employability
- Development and implementation of curriculum maps and common assessments
- Delivery of rigorous and relevant instruction
- Continue to implement the Ohio Improvement Process (OIP) with fidelity

Goal: Family & Community Relationships

AACS will partner with families and the community for student success.

Action Steps:

- Utilize community resources by effectively communicating with community partners
- Enhance communication by creating relationships with community/business partners and utilizing the Aim Higher
- Establish and maintain relationships with local agencies and businesses effectively by involving them within our district/instruction and all activities
- Support stakeholders by partnering with them and promoting positive involvement with our AACCS students
- Increase volunteer opportunities by first improving our internal communication with staff and families through outreach and community involvement





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GOAL: Safety, Facilities, & Technology

AACS will provide every student with safe, state of the art facilities, and technology that meets their academic, co-curricular & extra curricular needs.

Action Steps:

- AACS will provide 1:1 devices to each student PreK-12
- Technological resources will be available to every student PreK-12
- Develop District Technology Team
- Every building will have a compliant safety plan
- Staff will be trained and supported in learning and using de-escalation methods and PBIS
- Students will be taught safety procedures and how to be safe in different situations and settings
- Families and community will be informed about appropriate aspects of the safety plan that will not compromise safety - what to bring to reunite, etc
- AACS will open our facilities to the community for use outside of the student day

GOAL: Fiscal Resources

Maintain fiscal integrity and accountability of the AACS District .

Action Steps:

- Implement technology solutions in all administrative offices around the district to achieve efficiency gains
- To build confidence, continually educate all stakeholders (internal and external) in understanding district finances
- Engaging community in levy planning proactively
- Evaluate operational and staffing metrics to align district resources
- Provide necessary fiscal resources to maximize student performance
- To ensure effective and appropriate use of district funds, continually evaluate all revenue and expenditure sources
- Leverage financial resources to promote our schools



AIM HIGHER
