Youth Conservation Corps Job Announcement

The Turnbull National Wildlife Refuge will be sponsoring a Youth Conservation Corps (YCC) program this summer. The YCC program will employ four enrollees who will work 40 hours per week from June 25 through August 17, 2018. YCC crew members will earn \$11.50 per hour. Work projects may include trail maintenance and construction, fencing, painting, hand pulling invasive plant species, office and grounds maintenance, lawn care, and other physical outdoor work activities.

To be eligible to apply for the Youth Conservation Corps you must meet the following criteria:

- * Be between the ages of 15-18 during the summer employment period.
- * Be able to provide your own transportation daily to the Turnbull NWR headquarters, which is located 6 miles south of Cheney, WA.
- * Be willing to perform physical outdoor work activities.
- * Work the entire season with only emergency days of absence excused.
