Weatherford/Parker County Branch of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People

Scholarship: NAACP is offering a \$500 scholarship to a WHS senior who plans to attend Weatherford College.

Students must have a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale, take at least 12 hours at Weatherford College, and will need two letters of recommendation. Students will also need to submit an essay entitled, “If given the ability to change one moment in your life, would you do so? If so, what moment would you change and why?” **This scholarship is open to students of all races.** The deadline for submission is April 30, 2018, and students may pick up an application in the Counseling Center.

University of Texas at Arlington College of Education Scholarships: The UTA College of Education is offering two scholarships for future teachers. The \$5,000 Dean’s Undergraduate Teacher Education Scholarship is available for students based on their high school GPA and SAT/ACT scores. The \$2,500 Become a Teacher Scholarship is for students planning to major in Education with a 2.80 high school GPA or better. Applications are available online at www.uta.edu/coed/academics/scholarships.

Brazos Valley Scottish Rite Club Scholarship: The \$1,000 Brazos Valley Scottish Rite Club Scholarship application is available for students in Palo Pinto and Parker counties. Applications are available in the Counseling Center and the application deadline is April 24, 2018. Students must attach a recent photograph to their application and include a high school transcript, a copy of their SAT or ACT scores, two personal reference letters, and two academic reference letters. Every application is reviewed for the student’s achievements.

Weatherford Educational Support Association (WESA) Scholarship: WESA is offering two \$350 scholarships to students attending any college in the fall. Applicants will need to attach a transcript and two letters of recommendation to their application. Applications are available in the Counseling Center and the deadline to apply is April 6, 2018.

Martin Musicals Scholarship: High school seniors who are planning to pursue studies in Performing Arts after graduation are encouraged to apply for the Martin Musicals Scholarship. Applications are available in the Counseling Center and the application deadline is March 31, 2018. Students will need to include an essay with their application demonstrating their qualifications for the scholarship.

Larry Mangrem Scholarship: Students planning to attend The University of Texas at Austin are eligible for this \$1,000 scholarship. Applicants must fill out an application, enclose a transcript, and write a one-page essay about their career plans. Students will also need to enclose a copy of their Letter of Acceptance to UT. Come by the Counseling Center for an application. The deadline is April 27, 2018, and all future Longhorns need to apply!!

Azazie Scholarship: The Azazie Scholarship committee is offering a \$1,000 scholarship for students planning to attend college in the U. S. Students will need to complete a 500 - 800 word essay entitled, “What is a problem within the industry you are currently majoring in, and how will you solve this issue”. The essay needs to be emailed with the applicant’s name, address, phone number, and the name of the university of attendance to scholarship@azazie.com. The deadline for submission is May 31, 2018.

Sarah Jefferson Memorial Scholarship: The Sarah Jefferson Memorial Scholarship for \$500 is available to students planning to attend any college other than Weatherford College. Students will need to turn in a completed application, two letters of recommendation, an official transcript with tests scores, a letter of acceptance from their college, and a 250-300 word essay. Applications are available in the Counseling Center and the deadline to apply is April 30, 2018.

Vivint Smart Home Scholarship: Vivint Smart Home is offering five \$1,000 scholarships to students planning to attend college. The scholarship is not based on financial need and applicants must submit a video to apply. The video needs to be 1 – 2 minutes in length and in response to the prompt “How has the neighborhood you grew up in shaped you into the person you are today?” Students should go to www.vivint.com/scholarship to apply and the application deadline is May 1, 2018.

Society of Petroleum Engineering Scholarships: Students who qualify for the Gus Archie Memorial Scholarship may receive up to \$5,000 per year for four years. This is a merit based scholarship and students must be in the top 3% of their class. Students will also need to be in the top 3% with their standardized test scores. Students must be planning to major in Petroleum Engineering. Applications are submitted online and students applying will need to also submit a letter of recommendation from a counselor, teacher, or principal. Go to www.spe.org/scholarships to access the application. The deadline is April 15, 2018.
