

Sexual Harassment

Sexual harassment is against the law. It includes all unwanted, uninvited, and non-reciprocal sexual attention as well as the creation of an intimidating, hostile, or offensive school or work environment. This can include:

- Sexual harassment via electronic devices and social media, (Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, text messaging, etc.), as well as all other forms of cyber-bullying. These are regarded as illegal
- Sexually suggestive looks or gestures
- Sexual jokes, pictures, teasing
- Pressure for dates or sex
- Sexually demeaning comments
- Deliberate touching, cornering, pinching, "panting"
- Attempts to kiss or fondle
- Threats, demands or suggestions that favors will be granted in exchange for sex or tolerance of sexual advances

Cheating and Plagiarism

Students at Lahainaluna High School are expected to conduct themselves honestly and with integrity in their work. All forms of cheating and plagiarism are strictly prohibited. Behavior that is not acceptable includes, but is not limited to:

- Copying another student's homework
- Working with others on projects that are meant to be done individually.
- Looking at or copying another student's exam, test or quiz
- Taking an exam, a test or a quiz in part or whole to use or to give to others.
- Copying information from a source without proper attribution.
- Copying the work of other students, people, authors, publications, or the Internet.

Visitor Passes

STUDENT GUEST POLICY: Any guest of a student must **FIRST** receive clearance from an Administrator **before** requesting for an approved Visitor's Pass from the Main Office. Student guests of Lahainaluna students are usually not granted during the school day. Advance arrangement is preferred.

VISITOR POLICY: Lahainaluna High School welcomes and encourages parental involvement in their child's education. To ensure safety and instructional time all visitors to campus will prearrange the time with the teachers. All visitors are required to check in with the main office to receive a visitor pass and a parking pass(if applicable). This guest pass will be worn at all times while on campus. Parking pass will be displayed on vehicles dashboard and will be directed to a parking area. Teachers must submit in advance (at least two days prior) the "Visitor" form (green) through the main office.

ANY LUNCH OR OTHER DELIVERIES FOR STUDENTS SHOULD BE MADE THROUGH THE MAIN OFFICE AND NOT PERSONALLY DELIVERED TO A STUDENT.
