All fines/fees owed to DHS must be paid in full prior to purchasing a parking permit. Complete this form and submit to the office with proof of insurance, registration, and a valid Driver's License. Parking Permits for student paved lot are \$40 for the school year; permits for the north dirt lot are \$25. Dirt lot spaces are limited. Early graduates and students no longer attending classes at DHS must relinquish their parking permit. It is non-transferable.

Students driving vehicles to Durango High School MUST follow the regulations listed below:

1. The legal speed limit for driving on campus is 10 miles per hour. Reckless driving in the parking lots or violation of any of the regulations may result in loss of parking privileges. Students will comply with all directives given by DHS administrators and security officers.
2. A valid DHS parking permit is required for any student vehicle parked on school property. Parking permits are to be permanently located in the lower left corner (driver's side) of the front windshield. Removal of, or tampering with, a parking permit in any form will result in the loss of parking privileges on campus.
3. If a new vehicle is purchased during the school year, the old permit and required paperwork for the new vehicle must be turned into the office before a new permit will be issued.
4. A temporary parking permit must be requested from the office if a student is driving a vehicle other than the one registered at DHS and is unable to use the parking permit he/she was issued.
5. Students may park only in the Student Lot. No other parking is available for students. Areas designated for visitors, high school faculty, and the 55+ Center, are NOT to be used by students at any time, including Saturdays and holidays.
6. Vehicles parked in ANY unauthorized area or without the proper parking permit will be ticketed, booted or towed at the owner's expense. All tickets issued must be paid in full by the end of each trimester or parking privileges will be revoked until paid. Fines on tickets will be doubled if not paid within 30 days.
7. The following fines will be assessed for any violations of the above regulations: 1st Offense - \$10 Ticket, 2nd Offense - \$25 Boot, 3rd Offense - \$50 Boot, 4th Offense – Vehicle will be towed at owner's expense. A student's parking privileges at DHS may be REVOKED for any violation listed above, at any time. No refund of any type will be given for revoked parking privileges.
8. Durango High School reserves the right to search any vehicle parked in a DHS Lot. Students may not loiter in the parking lot during unscheduled periods.

Durango High School ASSUMES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OR DAMAGE TO VEHICLES PARKED ON THE CAMPUS.

By signing below, I (the student) agree to abide by all terms and policies listed above. I understand that all DHS parking lots are the property of School District 9-R and that any car driven to and parked on school property will not be used to transport or store illegal substances or items. I also understand that school officials and/or school security personnel have the authority to search a vehicle at anytime when parked on school property.
