1. As a Parent I will let players and coaches take responsibility for the first goal of winning. I will relentlessly focus on the second, more important, goal of using sports to teach life lessons to my student and other youth.
2. I will positively encourage my student, their teammates, and coaches.
3. I will reinforce the ELM approach with my child (E for Effort, L for Learning, M for bouncing back from mistakes). Because I understand ELM approach will help my child be successful in sports and in life, I will encourage my student to
 - put in a high level of effort to get better,
 - cultivate a Teachable Spirit to continue to learn and improve,
 - and to quickly rebound from mistakes.
4. I will set an example for my student by Honoring the Game and will encourage him/her to remember to respect for the Rules, Opponents, Officials, Teammates, and Self. If the official makes a “bad” call against my team, I will Honor the Game and be silent!
5. I will use a self-control to avoid losing my composure when things go wrong.
6. When cheering, I will limit my comments during the game to encouraging my student and other players (from both teams).
7. I will get my student to practice and games on time and will be on time picking my student up after games and practices.
8. I will refrain from making negative comments about my student’s coach in my student’s presence. I understand that this will help to avoid planting negative seeds in my student’s head that can negatively influence my student’s motivation and overall experience.
