

Public Notice of Teacher Quality (Highly Qualified)

The No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act of 2001 requires each Local Education Agency (LEA) to publicly report progress of the LEA and its campuses toward meeting highly qualified teacher requirements.

The following standards are required to be considered a Highly Qualified teacher:

- Has obtained Texas teacher certification
- Holds a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree
- Demonstrates subject matter competency in each of the academic subjects taught
- Competency is obtained by passing the Texas content exam and/or completing 24 college hours in the subject being taught (secondary classes only)
