

Graduation FAQs

Can I bring a bouquet of flowers and/or a lei into the stadium? What can I NOT bring into the stadium?

Ask yourself: Will it be a safety hazard, distract others, detract from the dignity of the occasion, or obstruct someone's view?

Example: Balloons are not allowed. They obstruct the view of others.

Example: Beach balls are not allowed. They distract others, detract from the dignity of the occasion, and someone could get hurt if the ball hits someone.

Example: A SMALL bouquet would be allowed. It will be in someone's lap until the end of the ceremony, and it won't obstruct the view of others if it stays in that person's lap for the duration of the ceremony. A LARGE bouquet is NOT allowed. It will obstruct the view of others during the ceremony.

What CAN I bring into the stadium?

No food. Only water.

When do I get the tickets?

Students will receive tickets at the graduation practice the morning of the ceremony. Under no circumstances will they be given out earlier.

How many tickets does each graduate get? How can I get more?

Ten are allotted per student. If you need more, have the student ask friends for the tickets they are not using. Also, at the start of the ceremony at 7:00 p.m., all persons that do NOT have tickets will be allowed into the stadium. Under no circumstances will more than 10 tickets be given per graduate. Tickets are NOT FOR SALE.

Are there concession stands inside the stadium? What do they sell?

No concessions are available inside the stadium. Only water is permitted.

What time does the stadium open for those holding tickets?

5:00 p.m.

What time does the stadium open up to those who do not have tickets?

At the start of the ceremony, which is 7:00 p.m.

Are we allowed to save seats?

No

Is there handicap seating?

Yes. Individuals that are disabled plus (only) 1 person to assist should go to the track gate on the north side of the home stands for access to seating on the track.

Do I need a ticket for a small child?

If they will be sitting on your lap, then they do not need a ticket. If they will be taking up a seat, then yes, they will need a ticket.
