- 4. Review: Executive Director's Report
 - New Leadership Roles & Introductions, Content Area Leads Both teachers shared their current roles at Valiente and their excitement to have joined the school team.
 - New Programs, Activities Scholar agendas to support homework. New tech support program Powerschool.
 - Enrollment Lost 3 4th grade scholars. 5th grade met projection. 6th grade at 27 students. 7th grade lost some scholars due to their family moving or families needing a school site closer to home. Implementing incentives to encourage enrollment. Concern is adding scholars to upper Middle School (7th grade).
 - Recruitment (Current & Future) SpEd students are making growths at Valiente and now more families are looking to Valiente as a community option for school choice. Anticipating a spike in cost for SpEd services due to higher SpEd enrollment. There is a positive reputation in the community that Valiente is a school that serves all students. Discussed new LAUSD Magnet school that opened in the community and strategies for creating a collaborative relationship with the school site and instructional team.
 - Academic Results (Prior & Current) Discussed new Academic Dashboard. From the results of the released data the academic team is focused on rethinking the testing strategy. Reading Plus is supporting the scholar's ability to have better testing endurance while supporting comprehension and vocabulary. Scatter plot data reveals that scholars are reading at a range from as low as early elementary (2nd grade) to as high as (10th/11th grade). Current suspension data for this year is at zero. No scholars have been suspended. In addition to decreasing suspension as a focus the organization is focusing on Instructional Minutes. The goal is that scholars are not being sent to the office/out of class for minor infractions.
 - Other News/Information Records request from CTA/UTLA created a need for the org to keep Procopio on retainer to support with this request. Clubs on campus have increased. Now there are 12 clubs offered with 4 new clubs being, Basketball/Karate & Debate/Forensics. The sports initiative will begin with a circuit training course. Afterschool program has 69 students and starts this Friday. Lastly, the first parent advisory committee meeting happened today, August 21, 2017. 24+ Parents had a lot of praise for the teachers and instructional program. All things shared were very positive. They love the strong bond with teachers and small class sizes. One parent was so pleased that "...Dr.

Perez knows every scholar's name!" They feel safe having their children here and they are happy about the opportunities offered on campus especially the clubs and after school program.
