- ✓ Independent Study students are advised of all college meetings on campus and encouraged to participate.
- ✓ CHAMPS' college counselor meets with individual Independent Study students to discuss college placement, scholarships, and recommendation letters for admissions.
- ✓ Tutoring is available by our Independent Study and in-classroom credentialed teachers.
