Definition of Human Sex Trafficking (HST):

The recruitment, transportation, provision, or obtaining of a person for the purpose of a commercial sex act, in which a commercial sex act is induced by force, fraud, or coercion, or in which the person to perform such an act is under the age of 18 years.



Why Educating Everyone About Minor Sex Trafficking is So Important:

- The primary target for traffickers is American girls **12 to 14 years old**.
- In 2013, **Texas** received the second highest number of calls to the trafficking hotline – second only to California.
- **Interstate 20** is America's #1 road for Human Sex Trafficking.
- City in the United States with the highest number of calls to the trafficking hotline – **Houston, TX!**
