Expectations and Academy Requirements

1. Students will maintain a 2.5 GPA. If a student falls below a 2.5 they will be placed on probation. Students will be given one quarter to bring their grades up. This may also require a commitment to tutoring. Grades may impact their ability to attend Field Trips.
2. Students will complete a 60 hour internship between their Junior and Senior year.
3. Students must complete 20 hours of community service each year. Community service is unpaid.
4. Students are expected to maintain good attendance. Failure to do so will impact the ability to attend Field Trips.
