Open to the public, from 8:30 a.m. – 12:00 noon today, over 100 students have teamed up to present and demonstrate their findings before a panel of judges from TSD, the University of Texas and Austin Community College (ACC).

Students are presenting 55 science projects in topics covering biology, chemistry, physics and anatomy.

Grand prizewinners in two divisions – Freshman/Sophomores and Juniors/Seniors - will receive an Apple iPad mini, and runners-up in both divisions will receive cash prizes, ranging from \$45.00-\$100.00.
