Granada Hills Charter High School's (GHCHS) After Hours Activities (AHA) afterschool program strives to create a generation of leaders who enrich school culture by empowering youth, engaging parents, administrators, and the community. Participants will receive academic assistance, participate in various enrichment and recreation activities, and have the opportunity to attend special events and field trips **FREE** of charge. AHA's goal is to support student success in the school through afterschool activities. In addition, AHA promises to provide a safe learning environment for your student and a nutritious snack during their participation.

Initials	ENROLLMENT Enrollment may be limited. Registration will be taken on a first come, first serve basis. Once classes reach enrollment capacity, students will be placed on a waiting list.
Initials	ATTENDANCE The AHA program will be open before school, after school, and some weekends (refer to the program's weekly schedule). Participants must attend a minimum of 30 minutes each day they participate in the program. In addition, if the student chooses to participate in an AHA enrichment/recreation activity, then the student must attend a minimum of four full GHCHS periods each day they participate in the activity. The goal of the after school program is to support student success in school through academics and enrichment.
Initials	BEHAVIOR POLICY Participation in the program is a privilege. AHA's rule is to be safe, respectful, responsible, and have fun. Disruptive or disrespectful behavior toward other students or program staff is grounds for dismissal from the program. Acts of violence toward another person will not be tolerated.
Initials	PARENTAL SUPPORT Though the program staff is committed and qualified, your help is needed to make the afterschool program be the very best it can be. You are an important partner in our program's success, and we look forward to your participation in parent workshops and meetings throughout the year.
