Kindergarten Registration for 2018-2019 School Year

Ashtabula Area City Schools will hold kindergarten registration on March 20 at Michigan Primary, March 21 at Huron Primary, and March 22 at Ontario Primary.

The times for registration are 10:00 am to 12:00 pm and 1:00 pm—3:00 pm. We will also hold one evening registration on March 20 at Michigan Primary from 4:30—6:30 pm.

Parents/guardians can attend registration at any of the schools. Choose the day that is most convenient for you. Registering at an individual building will not guarantee placement in that building.

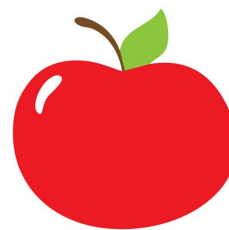
In order to attend kindergarten in the fall of 2018 a child must be 5 years old by August 1, 2018.

In order to complete the registration process parents will need to bring the following documents with them:

- **Child's birth certificate**
- **Child's social security card**
- **Statement of Residency**
- **Immunization record**
- **Custody papers if applicable**
- **Parent or Guardian's photo ID**
- **The child being enrolled**

During the registration your child will have an eye exam screener, a readiness assessment, visit a kindergarten classroom.

Registration packets are available at the Board of Education office at 2630 W. 13th St., the Early Learning Center, or at any of the primary schools. Parents can pick up the packet prior to registration and turn in the completed packet on the day of kindergarten registration.



Second and Third Grade Testing in March and April

During the weeks of February 26 and March 4 second grade students at Huron, Ontario, and Michigan Primary Schools will take the Iowa Test of Basic Skills and NNAT.

We are mandated by state law to test all students twice between two grade bands. AACCS will test second and fourth

graders. These assessments are used to identify students as Gifted and Talented. Results will be reported to parents in the spring.

Third grade students will take the AIR tests for English Language arts during the week of April 16—20. Math AIR testing

for grade 3 will take place April 23—27. These are computer based assessments. Students in grade 3 are required to achieve at least a reading promotion score of 672 overall or 44 for the reading portion to be promoted to grade 4.
