H7: TITLE I, PART A, PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT

Policy

The Milton Town School District maintains programs, activities, and procedures for the involvement of parents of students receiving services, or enrolled in programs, under Title I Part A of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act. These programs, activities and procedures are described in school district and school level compacts.

Definition

Parent: Includes a legal guardian or other person standing in loco parentis (such as a grandparent or step-parent with whom the child lives, or a person who is legally responsible for the child's welfare).

School District Parental Involvement Compact

The superintendent or his or her designee shall develop an LEA-Level Parental Involvement Compact according to Title I, Part A requirements. The LEA Compact shall include: (1) the school district's expectations for parental involvement, (2) specific strategies for effective parent involvement activities to improve student academic achievement and school performance, and (3) other provisions required by law. The superintendent or designee shall ensure that the Compact is distributed to parents of students receiving services, or enrolled in programs, under Title I Part A.
