Dear Holy Family Students and Parents,

Holy Family High School is very excited to announce our partnership again with Way to Go Schoolpool, a free, federally funded program of the Denver Regional Council of Governments. The goal of Way to Go is to help reduce traffic congestion and pollution, while providing Holy Family families with carpooling options to and from school.

We understand the difficulties associated with getting your children to school whether it be because of the distance, driving younger siblings to school, car issues, or driving to and from the many school events and sporting events our Holy Family students are involved with. Schoolpool provides a FREE service designed to match your family with other families who are within 7.5 miles of your address, who may have similar transportation issues and who you might be able to carpool with. In addition, many parents like to know who lives nearby for a sense of school community, so it is a great resource to meet nearby Holy Family families for other reasons such as transportation emergencies or baby sitters.

Your information will only be shared with other families from Holy Family High School, and families are not obligated to participate but may keep the information as a reference. Way to Go is simply a valuable resource for carpooling options.

Holy Family and Way to Go do not run background checks, confirm valid driver's licenses or assess insurance coverage on participants. It is the responsibility of the parent to investigate young driver laws regarding transporting other students.

Attached is more information about Way to Go and an Opt Out Notification form if your family does **NOT** want to participate in Way to Go for the 2017-2018 school year. Do not return the form if your family would like to participate in the Way to Go program next school year. If you do not return the form you will automatically be entered into the list of families who would like to participate and more information will be mailed to you before the start of the school year, so that you can begin planning before school begins in August.
