Thank you for supporting our students' vision to impact the world around them by helping us fund a greenhouse at Bemis.

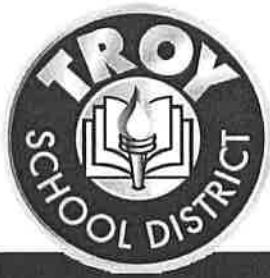

Choose Bemis Elementary.



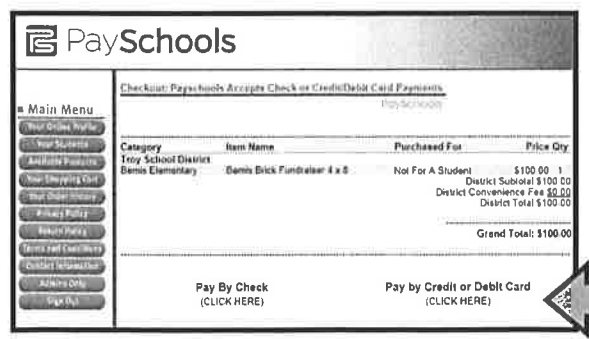
Find the brick size you would like to purchase. Then, press "Add to Cart".

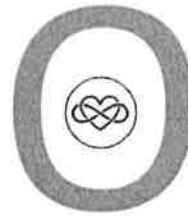

FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions)

What is Project R.O.O.T and what is its purpose?

Project R.O.O.T is a student led inquiry project. Students were asked how they could impact their community. The children wanted to help people who live in poverty (locally, across the state, and globally) by growing and harvesting organic food for the needy. While researching, students identified a challenge in that the Michigan climate does not support growing and harvesting crops during the school year. Therefore, they decided the best way to support their vision was to invest in an actual greenhouse that could be used during the school year.

Who will participate in Project R.O.O.T?

All classrooms will participate through our "Bemis Bear Buddy" program. Each upper grade is paired with a lower grade. The two classrooms meet at least 2 times per month (or as much as on a weekly basis). Each "Buddy" team will be responsible for their own growing table where they will plant, support, feed, harvest and distribute to the needy.

How does Project R.O.O.T support the TSD STEM initiatives?

The Bemis staff studied the Next Generation Science standards and found that every grade levels curriculum connects to the earth, plants and the scientific method. We believe that the greenhouse will become an extension science room where classrooms will be able to conduct live experiments, leverage technology to collect data and even partner with Michigan States Tollgate Farms to supply them with data to support the University studies. The potential for future careers that deal with the engineering of plants, medicine, space farming, aquaponics etc. will be explored throughout units of study.

How will the greenhouse be used and sustained year after year?

Project R.O.O.T has the potential to integrate all core curriculum into its everyday use. Year after year, the greenhouse will be a secondary learning structure where teachers can bring students in to facilitate and grow their learning in new ways. By incorporating the 6c's (collaboration, character, creativity, citizenship, communication, and critical thinking) into the greenhouse, the students will continue to see real world connections to the content they are learning. The students presented to the TSD Superintendent Cabinet and received approval for the sustaining costs of heating, electrical, and water.

What investment will be needed to purchase the necessary materials and to build the greenhouse?

Approximates: \$24,000 for an 18'x30' Greenhouse; \$8,000 for concrete; \$8,000 for infrastructure: gas, water, electrical.

Who are our financial partners and educational partners?

We have established many financial and educational contributors including, but not limited to...Oakland County Master Gardeners, MSU Tollgate Farms, Bordines, Telly's Greenhouse, The TSD Superintendent Cabinet and the Bemis PTO.

How can I get involved?

We are offering a wonderful opportunity for every parent and child to be involved to help us reach our goals. You can purchase one or more bricks with your child's or family name that will be installed inside of the greenhouse. Your child's name will be "rooted" in history at Bemis Elementary School. We hope that you will consider supporting this amazing student led project with a legacy investment. Our goal is to sell 200 bricks to support this project!

O: ORGANIC--Children at Bemis Elementary school believe we can help children in poverty. Our Project R.O.O.T will attempt to help those in need. Currently, around Oakland county there are approximately 40 thousand children living in families that are under the poverty line without the opportunity to eat healthy foods. Our goal is to grow and harvest organic leafy crops (salad): lettuce, cucumbers, tomatoes, strawberries and carrots on a monthly basis during the school year. We plan to organize our community and distribute to children within the oneTROY school district and beyond.



O: OPPORTUNITY FOR THE 4 L'S--we believe Project R.O.O.T will provide us the opportunity to live out the 4 L's. We will Learn about the sciences in Kinder--5th grade. The greenhouse will provide a Learning environment for us to observe, develop and distribute to those in need. We will Learn about respecting people in need, the responsibility to take care of the living plants in the greenhouse and being kind to others. Project R.O.O.T is rooted in the idea of Loving others, Locking arms together and Living out the belief that we can create opportunities to make a difference in our world.



T: TOGETHER -- we believe Project R.O.O.T will make a difference in the lives of people. We have connected our learning throughout Bemis and we believe this Creative project will help us to be better at Critical thinking, developing our Character and to be better Citizens.
