Students on Academic Rise (SOAR), an Early College High School, is a program with Advancement via Individual Determination (AVID) academic support as its foundation where students are simultaneously enrolled in high school and college courses.

SOAR looks for 8th graders that live within the AVUHSD boundaries and meet one or more of the following characteristics:

- low socioeconomic status;
- first generation college-going youth;
- underrepresented students; and
- students underperforming in the traditional setting who have the potential to be successful and to become productive citizens.

Objective Criteria

- Completed application by family
- 8th grade 1st semester report card (Baseline – 8th grade- 2.00 GPA - see application for more details)
- 7th grade (CAASPP Scores: standard nearly met or above - ELA / Math)
- Prior educational experience (See application)
- Recommendations from the middle school (See application)
- Parent and student interview
