The Madison County Health Department will be holding *Special Immunization*

Clinics for all school age children who need an updated “Blue Card” for school entry. This will include, but is not limited to, all children entering daycare or kindergarten/1st grade, all children between the ages of 11 - 14 and all children entering 6th grade who are 10 and over.

The immunization clinics will be held at the *Madison County Health Department, 301 Max Luther Drive, Huntsville, AL, 35811* on the following schedule:

August 1st: 8:30 - 11:30 and 1:00 - 4:00
August 2nd: 8:30 - 11:30 and 1:00 - 4:00
August 3rd: NO CLINIC
August 4th: 8:30 - 11:30 and 1:00 - 4:00
August 5th: NO CLINIC



Week of August 8 - 12: 8:30 - 11:00 and 1:00 - 4:00

Parents must bring the child's shot record with them.

Immunization “Blue Cards” are required for school entry in the State of Alabama. If your child does not have an up-to-date “Blue Card” they ***WILL NOT*** be allowed to enter school.
