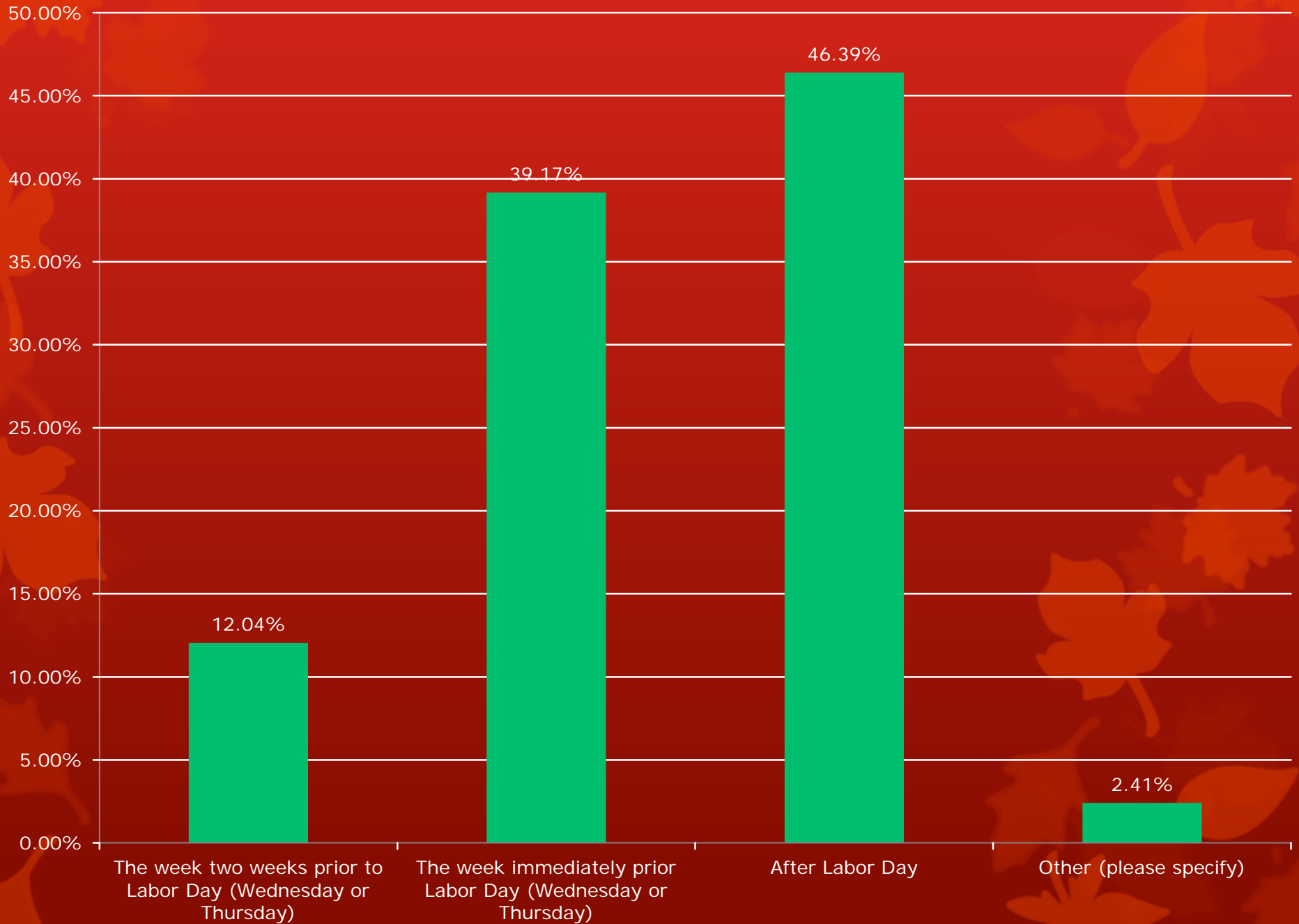

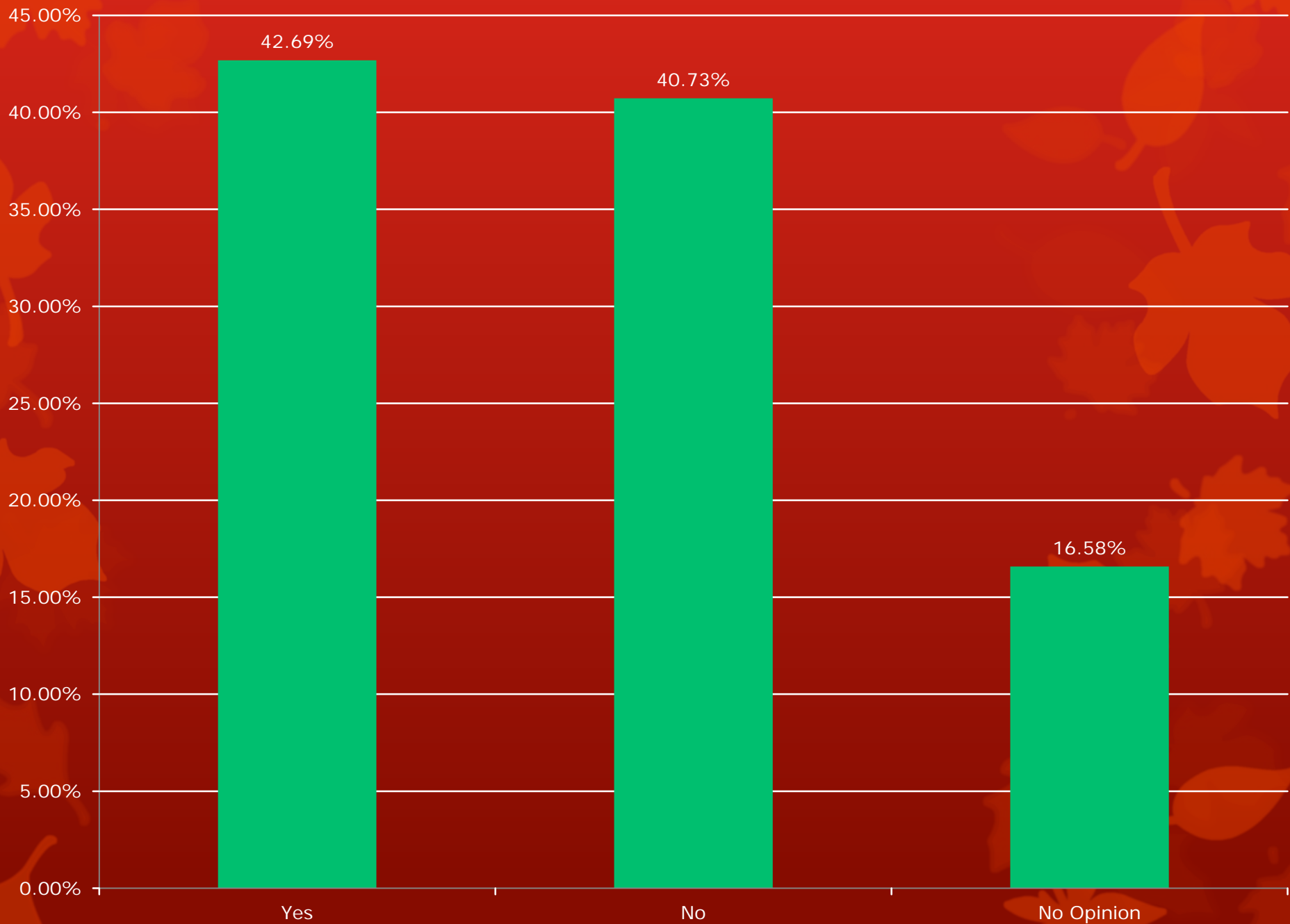
What school(s) are you a stakeholder of (select all that apply)?



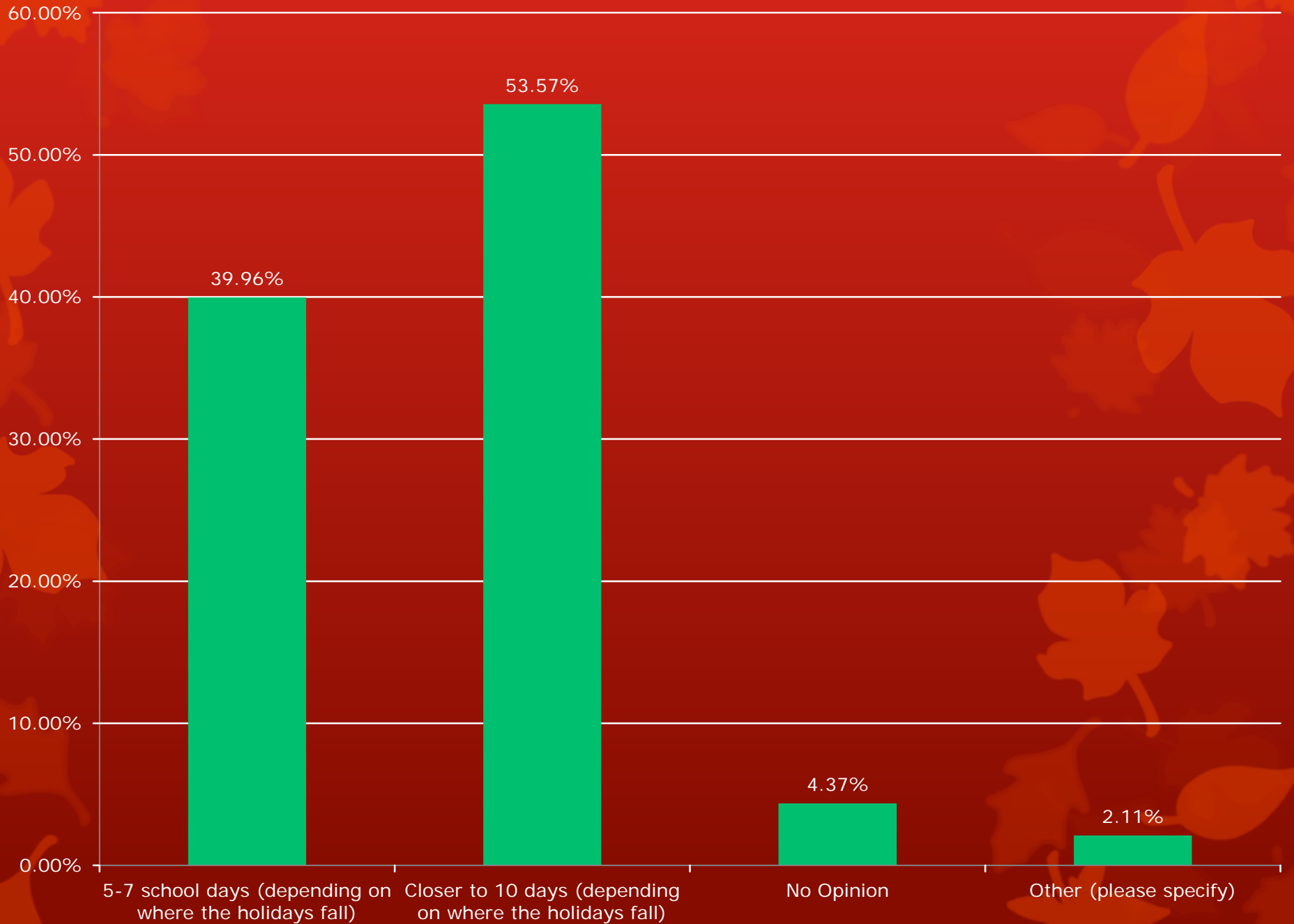

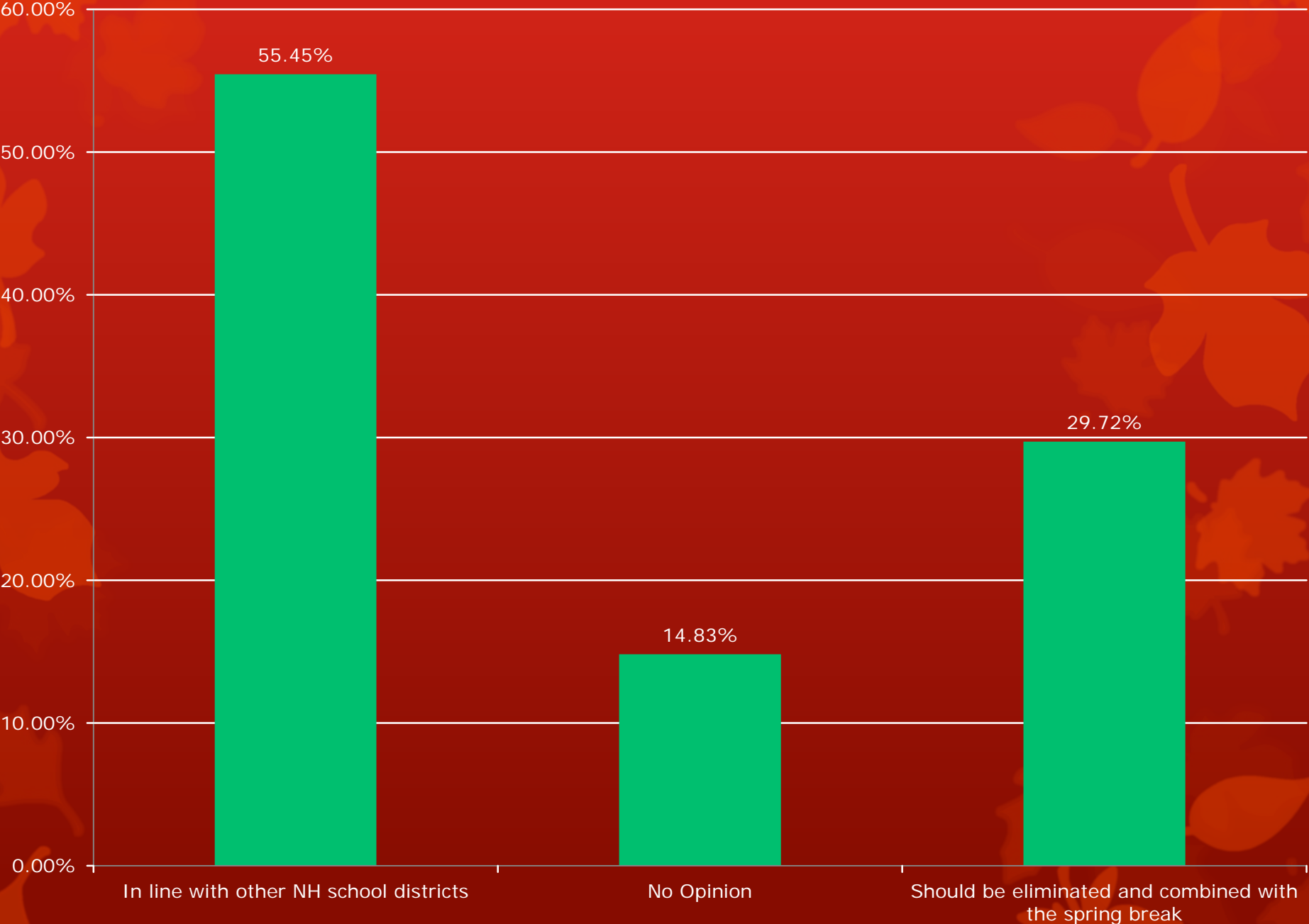
Should the calendar include a short break (long weekend) between Labor Day and Veteran's Day, in October?



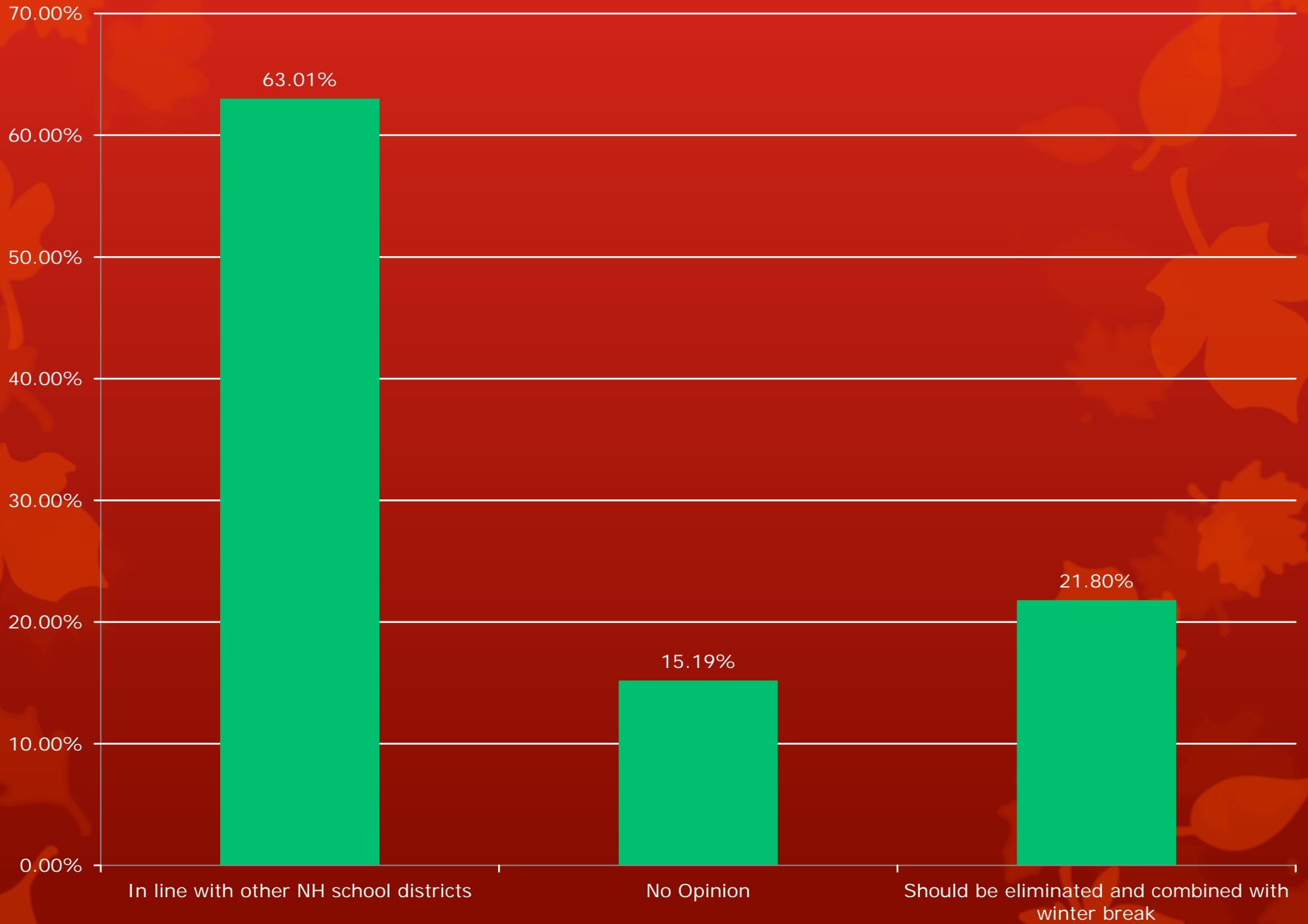
How long should the holiday break in December run?



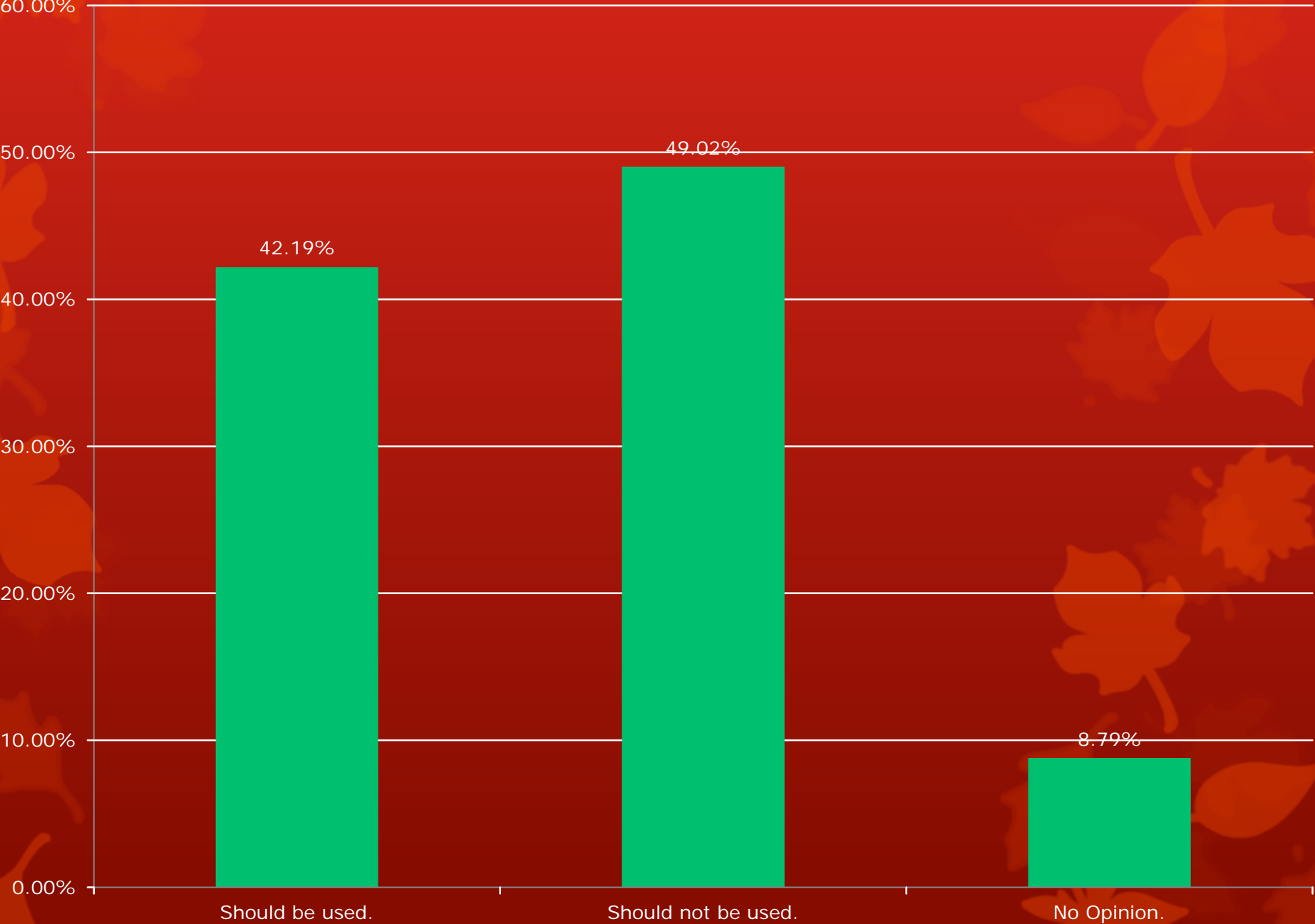
When should the winter break fall?



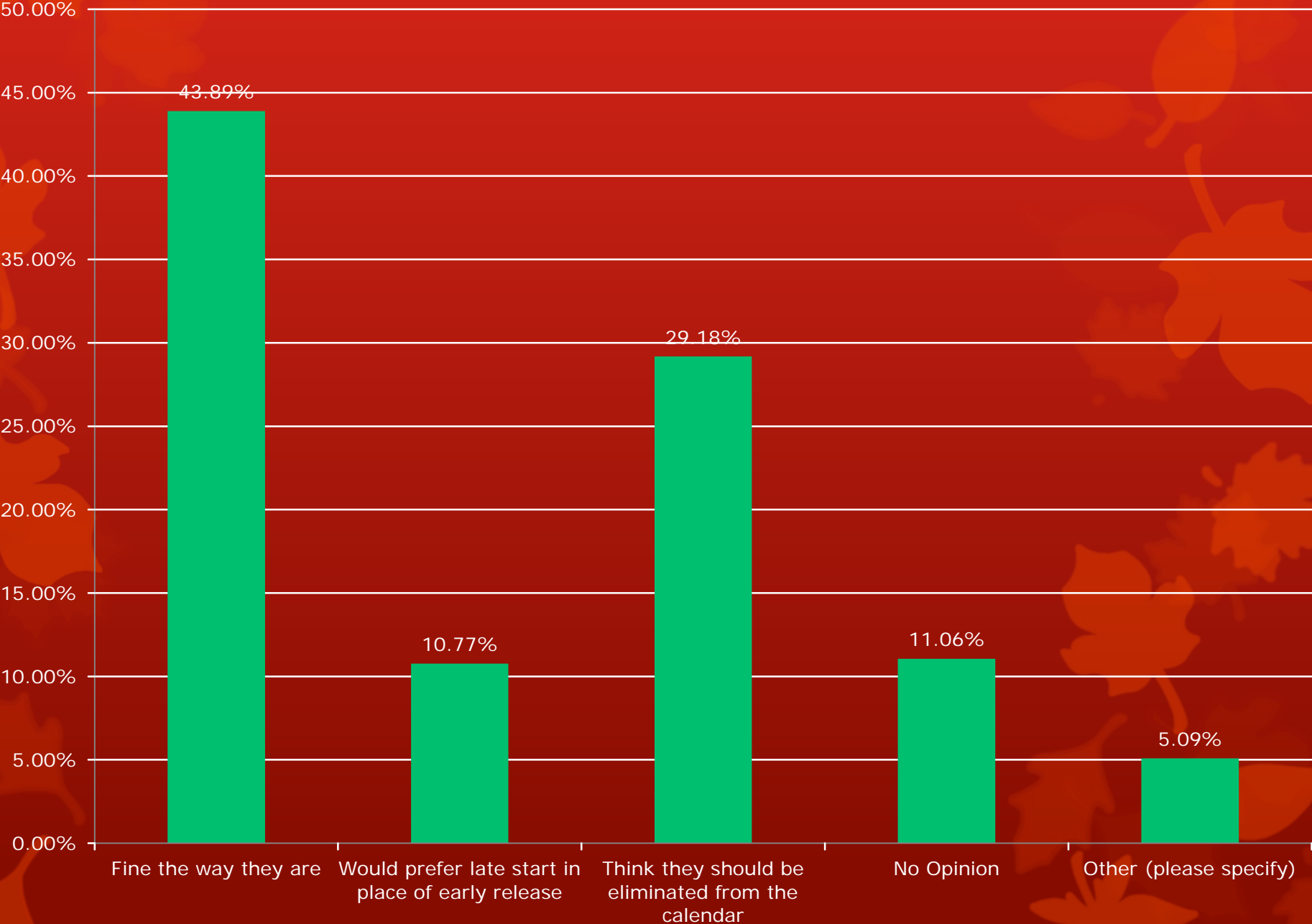

In order to help prevent the last day of school from running into late June, how do you feel about building in flexible make-up days in the event of school cancellations?



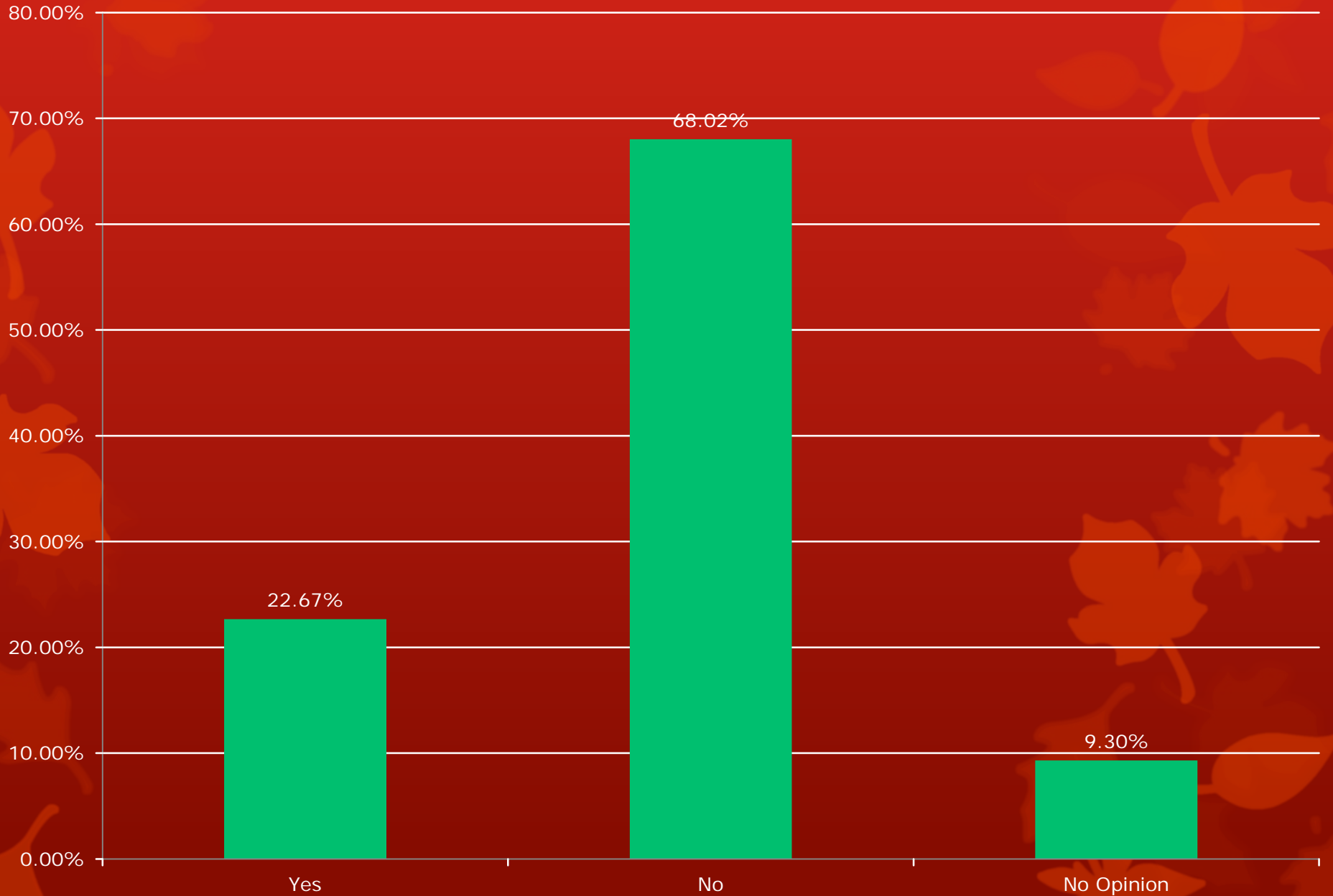

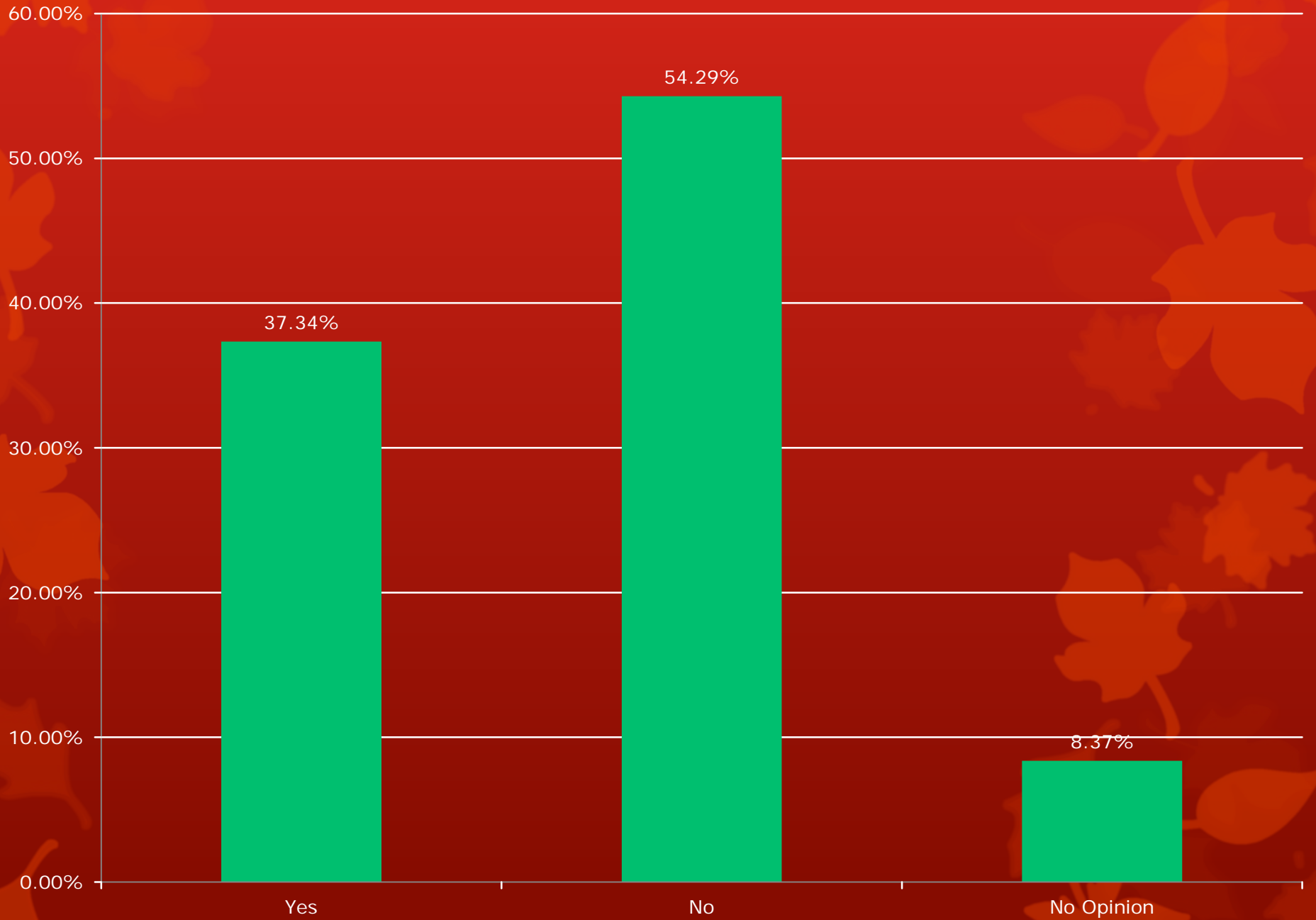
