



SENIOR CONTRACT- Class of 2018

**THIS CONTRACT IS TO BE SIGNED AND RETURNED TO MS. TORRES IN THE COUNSELING OFFICE
NO LATER THAN Friday, October 6, 2017.
Failure to return the contract on time will result in failure to participate in Senior Activities.**

I understand that participating in this year's senior activities and the graduation ceremony is a privilege. To be eligible to participate, I must maintain the established criteria for academic achievement, attendance, and behavior during both fall and spring semesters of my senior year. To ensure that I may participate in the senior events and/or the graduation ceremony, I understand that I must meet all the following criteria:

ACADEMIC:

- Pass all classes receiving a grade of D or better. No Fails.
- Eligibility for the fall semester will be determined based on the 20-week report card. Those not meeting eligibility requirements will not participate in GradNite.
- Eligibility for the spring semester will be determined based on the 15-week report card. Those not meeting eligibility requirements will not participate in Graduation Ceremony.
- Complete WRC/Interview requirements.
- Complete minimum graduation requirements (210 credits, SLP, Health)

ATTENDANCE:

- Maintain good attendance in all classes.
- Must maintain 96% attendance or higher during both the fall and spring semesters to participate in Senior Activities including Graduation.
- All tardies must be cleared. 3 tardies = 1 hour detention.
- Detentions will satisfy attendance requirement to participate in activities, but will not increase attendance percentage. The only way to increase attendance percentage is to attend school.

BEHAVIOR:

- Behave in a mature, responsible manner following the Falcon Traits at all times.
- Clear all detentions for tardies with the Dean prior to the Fall 20-week report card and Spring 15-week report card to participate in senior activities.
- Avoid suspension for any reason during Senior Year. If suspended, student will be placed on probation by Dean and will jeopardize eligibility to participate in activities including graduation ceremony.
- If a student has been found under the influence or possession of a controlled substance on campus or school sponsored event (any time during the year), that student will **NOT** be eligible to attend **GRAD Night** and/or participate in other future Senior Activities, including graduation. Deposits will **NOT be REFUNDED!**
- If a student is found under the influence or possession of a controlled substance at **GRAD Night**, the student will **NOT** be eligible to participate in Graduation.
- Satisfy all requirements of the Probation Contract for participation (if applicable).

OTHER:

- Pay all outstanding fines/fees to Santee Education Complex for textbooks, library books, athletic uniforms, etc. prior to graduation ceremony.
- Attend **MANDATORY** graduation practices on **June 1st, 4th, 5th, and 6th**, 2018. No student will be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony if he/she fails to attend the graduation practice. Plan ahead. There will be no accommodations made for work or other outside commitments.
- **Senior Parents** are **expected** to attend 4 school activities, 2 face to face conferences/workshops and 2 can be extracurricular activities.

If I fail to meet the criteria outlined in this document, I will become ineligible to participate in any of the senior events and/or the graduation ceremony.
