New Business

1. Update on state of school
 - Current enrollment at 562
 - Students are doing well with the change to uniforms

2. Data review for the 2016-2017 school year
 - Student and Staff attendance
 - Student average 96.37%
 - Staff average 94.49%
 - Data Summary
 - Reviewed year end benchmark levels
 - LLP is pushing students to exceed system goal level by at least 1 level. Example: 3rd grade system goal is to be at a

level P, LLP wants students to be a level R so that they are better prepared to pass the GMAS.

- LLP will be looking to make intervention changes to better assist those students who are struggling to reach grade level.
 - GMAS school data review
 - Students did extremely well in the math portion ranking in the top 20% of all the schools in the state
 - LLP outperformed the Tift County school system and the state averages in reading, writing, and math.
 - Parent involvement survey
 - Reviewed responses from online survey taken in the spring
 - Majority responded with “excellent” or “good” on all questions asked
3. Review of 2017-2018 School Improvement Plan
- Goal 1 : Reading – The percent of students who meet or exceed guided reading levels goals based on LLP expectations will increase for every grade.
 - Goal 2: Writing – Continue writing curriculum with fidelity while implementing test writing genre
 - Goal 3: Math – Students will increase from 53% to 58% scoring as proficient or distinguished learners in Math as measured by GMAS.
4. Identify improvement goal for principal evaluation
- Recommended goal: The percent of students who meet or exceed guided reading levels goals based on LLP expectations will increase.
