

## General Rules:

1. **ALL ART POSTER ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY BRENT SCARPO/CONSUELO FLORES NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, MARCH 16, 2018 TO BE CONSIDERED.**

2. All Raymond Cree Middle School Students are eligible to enter.
3. **Students are allowed to create ONE entry per student.** The entry must no larger than 24' x 36' no less the 11' x 17'.
4. All artwork must be completed by the students.
5. All posters must be clearly labeled with the student's name on the back of the poster.
6. Artwork can be done using: paints, markers, computer art, digital art and/or pen and ink. Collages are welcomed too. Students should keep in mind artwork may be reproduced and full color artwork is preferred.
7. The winning poster will be reproduced as determined by Raymond Cree Middle School. All entries will become the sole property of Raymond Cree Middle School and may be reproduced by Raymond Cree Middle School for any purpose and in any form.
8. From all submitted entries, there will be 5 posters selected as finalists.
9. The winning entry will receive a cash prize of **\$150** for the student.
10. The next second runners-up will receive a cash prize of **\$75** and the third runners-up will receive a cash prize of **\$50**.
11. Two additional entries will be selected as Honorable Mention and will receive certificates of recognition.
12. All winning and non-winning posters become the property of the Raymond Cree Middle School **AND WILL NOT BE RETURNED.**
13. The **FIVE WINNERS** will be announced at the evening program on Thursday, April 12, 2018 at Raymond Cree Middle School. **IMPORTANT: ALL ENTRIES MUST ATTEND IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED ONE OF THE FIVE WINNERS!! FAILURE TO ATTEND THE EVENING PROGRAM WILL BE CONSIDERED A DISQUALIFICATION!**
