Car Pick-Up

For families who utilize the drive through to pick up their kids, please keep the following procedures in mind:

- Display your *Student Pick-Up Card* in your front passenger window. This allows staff on duty to quickly call for students.
- Pull all the way forward in your car.
- Please include the teacher name on the pick-up card if it is not already there. This makes it easier for teachers to send students to the car.
- Please stay in your car. We will load students for you.

Gate Pick-Up

For families walking up and meeting their kids at the west gate, please keep the following procedures in mind:

- Hold your Student Pick Up card up so that the staff member on duty can call your child to the gate.
- The duty teacher will start calling names from the fence closest to the building and proceed toward the grass area.
- Families need to leave a clear path for students to exit the gate.
- Students will be asked to point to the person picking them up as they reach the gate.
- The adult picking up should raise a hand when they see their child pointing. This allows staff to clear the child for exiting the playground.
