



## HEALTH POLICY CHANGE

August 1, 2017

Dear Parents and Guardians,

In our continuing efforts to ensure the health and safety of all WISD students and to be in compliance with the Texas Administrative Code, Waxahachie ISD is making the following change to the student handbook regarding the fever policy:

**A student with a temperature 100.0° F (formerly 100.4° F) or higher will be excluded from school. The temperature must be below 100.0° F (formerly 100.4° F) for a full 24 hours before returning to school without the use of Tylenol, Advil, Motrin or other medications designed to reduce fever.**

Please know that we want all WISD learners to be in the best possible health at all times. We take the well-being of our students very seriously and want to provide the optimum atmosphere for education. Thank you for your adherence to this policy and for helping us keep the students of Waxahachie safe and well.
