4. **LOREN HOLMES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** is a local scholarship intended to help the hard "C" student achieve higher education. Scholarship is available in the counseling office. **Deadline is April 20, 2018.**

16. **THE IVC EOP TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP** is available to a student who is committed to supporting the mission of MANA de Imperial Valley and who meets the following requirements: have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent); have plans to transfer to a four-year U.S. accredited institution or technical college during the 2018-2019 academic year; and demonstrates community service/school activities' involvement. **Deadline April 27, 2018.**
