Seven Important Things to Make Your Transition a Smooth One

1. **Bookmark the Foothill High School website:** www.foothillfalcons.org Everything you want to know about Foothill is there: school calendar, campus map, teachers/staff, athletics, booster groups, webstore etc.
2. **Join us on the PTSA.** Dues are just \$20 per adult per year and \$10 per student per year and we welcome all members of the Foothill community.
3. **Stay in the Know.** There are two key ways Foothill and Foothill PTSA communicate:
 - a. **Follow us on Facebook.** Like “Foothill High School PTSA” on Facebook.
 - b. **Sign Up for the Bi-Weekly Talon Talk newsletter.** This is the best way to keep up-to-date on all Foothill happenings. Simply click the ‘sign up’ button in the bottom right corner of the Foothill website.
