Back to School Information 2017-2018

Welcome to the new school year. We are excited to see all of our new and returning students! Please refer to the following information to help you and your student have a successful first week.

- Before school starts, click on the “enrollment” link on the Hawthorne website, haw.bhusd.org.
- Fill out the forms that pertain to your child for new student enrollment OR returning registration. Please print THREE copies of the emergency card to bring to your child’s teacher on the first day of school.
- Read the files specific to Hawthorne: Middle School Tardy Policy, Hawthorne School Bullying Policies and Policies for Cheating, Cell Phones and Dress Code. Print and bring ONE copy of the document acknowledgement signature page to your child’s teacher on the first day of school.
- Be sure to click on the link for PTA news list (on the Hawthorne home page, right side), so you will receive weekly newsletters with important information.
- Suggested school supply lists are on the “bulletin board” section of the Hawthorne home page. If your child’s grade level or subject area is not listed, the teacher will provide this information to your student on the first day of school. Please note that students in grades TK-3 may not use rolling backpacks at school as they can pose a safety risk.
- All class lists for TK-8 will be available from 8:00am-2pm on Sunday, August 13th at our Pancake Breakfast Kick Off.
- On the first day of school, arrive early and park on neighboring streets if you plan on walking your student to his or her classroom. Parents of students in TK-5 will be allowed to escort their students to their classroom on the first day of school only (first three days for TK and kindergarten). After that, all parents must sign in at the office if they have an appointment to see the teacher or are on campus for another activity.

- On the opening day of school class lists for TK-5 will be posted on the south field fence. Once you find your teacher, you may walk to that classroom.
- Middle school homeroom teachers and class lists will be posted on the north field fence. Students should go to their homerooms where teachers will distribute a daily class schedule to each of the students.
