

**TITLE***Plumber***QUALIFICATIONS**

- Able to read, write, speak and understand English.
- At least one (1) year of experience with plumbing systems; and
- Meets the health and physical qualifications.

**JOB GOAL**

To help maintain the physical school plant in a condition of operating excellence so that full educational use of it may be made at all times.

**ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS**

- Assumes responsibility for the safe condition of pipes, drains, and plumbing fixtures in school facilities;
- Unclogs and installs drains, coolers, commodes, and urinals;
- Supervises maintenance of outdoor sprinklers, waste disposal systems, radiators, and similar plumbing-related installations;
- Recommends supplies and equipment for purchases, and maintains the inventory of system-owned tools, equipment, and supplies;
- Estimates costs of plumbing repair projects in terms of labor, material, and overhead;
- Examines school facilities on a regular basis for purposes of preventive maintenance; and
- Is of good moral character, able-bodied, courteous, and cooperative.

**PHYSICAL DEMANDS**

This job may require lifting of objects that exceed 50 lbs., with frequent lifting and/or carrying of objects weighing up to 25 lbs. Other physical demands that may be required are as follows:

- Lifting, carrying, pushing and/or pulling
- Climbing and/or balancing
- Stooping, kneeling and/or crawling
- Reaching
- Seeing

## **VOCATIONAL PREPARATION**

The required vocational preparation may come from any of the following:

- Vocational education
- Apprentice training
- On-the-job training
- Essential experience

## **TEMPERAMENT (Personal traits)**

- Adaptability to performing a variety of duties, often changing from one task to another of a different nature without loss of efficiency or composure.
- Adaptability to accepting responsibility for the direction, control, or planning of an activity.
- Adaptability to dealing with people.
- Adaptability to making generalizations, evaluations, or decisions based on sensory or judgmental criteria.

## **CAPACITY AND ABILITY REQUIREMENTS**

Specific capacities and abilities may be required of an individual in order to learn or perform adequately a task or job duty.

- *Intelligence:* The ability to understand instructions and underlying principles. Ability to reason and make judgments.
- *Manual Dexterity:* Ability to move the hands and fingers and manipulate small objects with the fingers rapidly or accurately.
- *Eye Hand Foot Coordination:* Ability to move the hand and foot coordinately in response to visual stimuli.

## **WORK CONDITIONS**

High degree of discomfort due to exposure to dust, noise, temperature, and hazardous materials.
