Performance Meter Goal **2016-2017**: For all students to maintain Proficient/Advanced Attendance
Proficient/Advanced Attendance (96% or higher) is maintained by having no more than 1 absence for every 25 days of instruction (maximum of 7 absences in 180 day school year).

- Currently, 63% of students are reaching the attendance goal of 96% or higher.
- Based on the School's End of the Year Magic Number, we need 46 more students to meet our 96% goal.
- 12th grade (72%), followed by 11th (66%), 10th (60%), 9th (59%) has the highest percentage of proficient attendance.
- 10th grade (23%), followed by 9th (21%), 11th (15%), 12th (15%) have the lowest percentage of proficient students.
