

ATHLETIC REQUIREMENTS

Jefferson-Morgan School District

Age Guidelines

You may not have reached your 19th birthday by June 30th immediately preceding the school year.

The age of 15 where interscholastic competition limited to grades 7-8.

The age of 16 where limited to grades 7 through 9.

Attendance

If you are absent from school during a semester for a total of 20 days, whether they are excused or unexcused (including school suspensions), you will lose your eligibility until you have been in attendance for a total of 45 days following your 20th day of absence. This is a Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association guideline and can not be circumvented by the Jefferson-Morgan School District. Eligibility must be ruled on by the WPIAL or the PIAA. This policy carries through adjacent school years.

Academic Performance

As prescribed in the PIAA handbook and as adopted by the Jefferson-Morgan School District, to be academically eligible to participate in athletics, a student/athlete must be passing four (4) one-credit courses for eligibility. If a student/athlete is declared ineligible, he is unable to participate in any competitions the following week (Sunday through Saturday). Grades will be checked every week by athletic personnel and conveyed to the student and coach if they are found to be ineligible.

The day report cards are issued, if a student has not received four (4) one credit passing grades, he will be deemed ineligible for a period of 15 school days, beginning the day report cards are issued.
