

MATH LAB PROPOSAL

- PURPOSE:** As a Response to Intervention, the Math Lab will assist students in passing essential standards through re-teaching, re-learning, and re-testing. The Math Lab will provide additional support for students and teachers by offering students guided practice outside of class and opportunities to demonstrate proficiency on the essential content standards throughout the semester. Teachers may refer students who need to retest/makeup a standard or need additional practice on a standard. Students can also “self refer” if they want extra practice on a standard. ***This is not intended for homework help or detention.***
- DESCRIPTION:** The Math Lab will use a combination of small group instruction, one-on-one tutoring, and IXL to support students’ learning. After students have adequately prepared (to be determined by the Math Lab teachers) for the standard, they will be offered a retake on the standard to be created, administered, and graded by the Math Lab teacher. Results will be sent to the student’s current math teacher to be reflected in their grade.
- WHEN:** Mondays and Wednesdays from 2:15-4:45 PM
- WHERE:** Learning Lab with access to desktop computers and laptops
- WHO:** Students who need targeted intervention for the Essential Standards in Algebra 1, Geometry, or Algebra 2.
- HOW:** Teachers will be invited to apply for the Math Lab teacher position. This teacher will run the lab from 2:15-3:30 PM, and Mrs. Slavoski will run the lab from 3:30-4:45 PM. The Math Lab teachers will be compensated at the professional rate.
- EVALUATION:** The Math Lab’s productivity and effectiveness will be analyzed at the end of the semester. Possible changes may include (but are not limited to): additional staffing, alternative online programs that include instructional videos, and options for other uses/objectives of the Math Lab.
