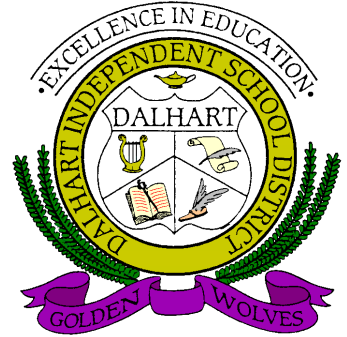

CHILD NUTRITION CHARGE POLICY

Students may charge up to one week's worth of meals, Elementary and Intermediate Schools, \$12.50, Junior High and High Schools, \$13.75, on their lunch accounts. Once they have reached that limit they will receive a reimbursable meal. Letters are sent home weekly to ensure parents/guardians are aware the student's account has reached a negative balance. In addition to letters, the parents/guardians will receive an automated phone call to remind them their child has a negative balance.

Payments can be made by setting up an account on myschoolbucks.com or payments can be brought to your child's school cafeteria.
