Central Region Chapter Officer Leadership Conference

October 5 - 6, 2013

This activity involves the seven FFA Officers and the advisors. This conference is designed to train the officers for the specific duties related to their office. It will be held at Denair High School in Denair. The officer team may spend the night at the conference site, return home for the evening, or stay at a hotel in Turlock.

National FFA Leadership Conference

October 27 or 29 – November 2 or 5, 2013
