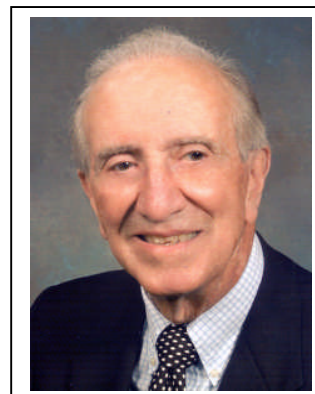


Elbert “Eb” Blakely
