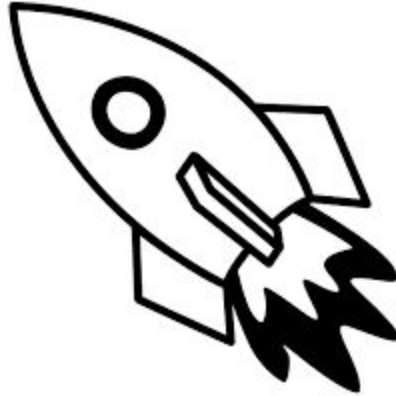
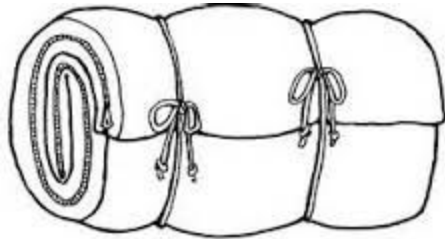


Preparing for Astrocamp
