Academic Achievement Group Projects

PRIORITY VOTING RESULTS:

TOP PRIORITY IS A TIE:

Expand Summer School - 127 votes as top priority

Expand Algebra 1 & 2 Support - 127 votes as top priority

Expand Tutorial Program (writing lab, math lab, online tutor, study center) - 121 votes as 2nd priority

Projects voted upon:

- Expand STEM/STEAM programs - Offer credit earning classes such as robotics, engineering, and coding in addition to after school clubs (LCAP Goals #7, #15).
- 10th grade Humanitas program in English and History to support Advanced Placement course readiness. (LCAP Goals #6, #9,#10).
- Dolphin Leadership Academy (Summer bridge program for incoming freshman) incoming 9th grade students – Expand program to include more incoming 9th grader students (LCAP Goals #6, #10, #12,#16, #18).
- Summer School – Expand summer course opportunities to include credit recovery, courses for advancement, and Advanced Placement readiness (LCAP Goals #6, #10, #12,#16, #18).
- Algebra 1 and 2 support - Increase review sessions offered and embed in Math Lab (LCAP Goals #6, #8, #10).
- Study skills support – Expand number of sections offered (LCAP Goals #6, #8, #10).
- Literacy support – Expand number of course sections to include 10th grade (LCAP Goals #6, #8, #10, #18).
- Standards aligned materials - Purchase or develop instructional materials that reflect new state standards in all core courses (LCAP Goal #2).
- World Language offerings – Expand language options (including American Sign Language) through on-line and independent options (LCAP Goals #10, #15).
- Tutorial options – Offer an expanded tutorial program including writing lab, math lab, IXL, online tutor, and study center (LCAP Goals #6, #8, #9, #10).
- College and Career related opportunities such as field trips, guest speakers, seminars, etc (LCAP Goals #7, #10).
- College and Career readiness support program (such as AVID), especially for those students traditionally underrepresented in higher education (LCAP Goals #6, #8, #9, #10, #12).

Family and Community Group Projects

PRIORITY VOTING RESULTS:

Career Consultant - **94 votes as top priority**

Translation Technology - **88 votes as 2nd priority**

Projects voted upon:

- Part-Time Career Education Consultant to support expansion of Career Center related services (LCAP Goal #7).
- Translation technology to facilitate more effective communication with all members of the PCHS community (LCAP Goal #5, #7).
- Parent technology training on using school communication systems such as Schoology and Infinite Campus (LCAP Goal #5, #7).

Finance Development & Fundraising Group Projects

PRIORITY VOTING RESULTS:

Transportation Scholarships - **102 votes as top priority**

Target Specific Fundraising Goals - **86 votes as 2nd priority**

Projects voted upon:

- Grant and Development Director - Bring on board an experienced fundraiser to coordinate grant applications, develop corporate relationships, and facilitate alumni outreach (LCAP Goals #4, #20).
- Transportation scholarships - Increase financial support to students who contract with Tumbleweed Transportation, outside transportation provider (LCAP Goal #15)
- Target specific fundraising goals (LCAP Goal #7)
- Maximize cafeteria revenue through improved service/menu options (LCAP Goals #11, #14)

Operations and Facilities Group Projects

PRIORITY VOTING RESULTS:

Air conditioning for classrooms - **166 votes as top priority**

Classroom updates/renovations - **156 votes as top priority**

Projects voted upon:

- Classroom updates and renovations to meet demands of 21st century instruction
- Student restroom renovations to ensure safety and cleanliness
- Replace outdated furniture in classrooms
- Athletic facilities upgrades including replacing the track and field
- Air conditioning for classrooms
- Security camera expansion
- Emergency/crisis supplies and training for staff

Technology Group Projects

PRIORITY VOTING RESULTS:

Expand STEAM (robotics, game design, etc.) - **122 votes as top priority**

Expand Online Course offerings – **98 votes as top priority**

Projects voted upon:

- Expansion of the 1:1 program to provide all grade levels with Chromebooks, thus ensuring widespread equity in access to technology and placing the student at the center of the implementation (LCAP Goal #15)
- Expansion of engineering programs to offer more options in STEAM areas that connect to local college, grad school and industry programs. These include robotics, game design, creative programming and virtual reality film production. (LCAP Goals #7, #15)
- Redesign of school website to facilitate more efficient communication, with a focus on multi-lingual text and graphic design that better promotes our campus climate, diversity and beautiful location. (LCAP Goals #5, #14)
- Expansion of online course offerings to bring greater breadth to our course catalog (LCAP Goals #4, #17)
- Installation of ceiling or wall mounted projectors in the bungalow classrooms to alleviate safety hazards caused by cables in small spaces. (LCAP Goal #3)
