### **Olweus Survey**

In the next few weeks students in grades 3-8 will be taking the Olweus Bullying Questionnaire (OBQ). This is the fourth year for St. Anthony School to take this survey. This **anonymous** survey provides data on the social climate at St. Anthony School from the student's point of view. Information gathered is used to support our students with positive reinforcements and needed interventions throughout our school. ### **Fulcrum Tuition Assistance Program**

The Fulcrum Tuition Assistance Program is now open for St. Anthony School Families. Click on the link below to access the site.

For the Fulcrum Tuition Assistance Program:

- Applications are completed and submitted completely online.
- Nothing will be printed or signed and turned into the school.

Along with the application, each family is asked to pay a \$24 fee to FACTS to apply for Fulcrum tuition assistance. The \$24 fee covers all applications for 1 year, and will be fully reimbursed so long as their student(s), regardless of whether they are awarded a Fulcrum grant or not, enrolls in a Catholic school for the 2017-2018 school year. If you have more than one child attending a Catholic school, only one application and one fee is required.

The deadline for submitting your application online is January 6, 2017.

No Fulcrum Applications will be accepted or considered for funding after the deadline.

The application is available in both English and Spanish.

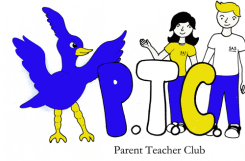
