Walnut Valley EDUCATIONAL Foundation (WVEF) is an independent, non-profit organization dedicated to ensuring a quality education for the children of Walnut and Diamond Bar. To that end, we will raise financial support and develop fiscal resources to fund a wide variety of enrichment and extra curricular opportunities for students and staff within the Walnut Valley Unified School District (WVUSD).

## WALNUT VALLEY EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

During each academic year, WVEF will award scholarships to WVUSD staff and graduating senior students. The scholarships to WVUSD graduating senior students will be awarded as follows:

- ◆ Three (3) scholarships of \$1,000 each to DBHS graduating senior students
- ◆ Three (3) scholarships of \$1,000 each to WHS graduating senior students
- ◆ Two (2) scholarships of \$1,000 each to Alternative Education High School graduating senior students

The above scholarships will be awarded in one or more of the following categories:

- ◆ Visual and Performing Arts Scholarship
- ◆ Teen Citizen Scholarship
- ◆ Industrial Technology Scholarship

Additionally, WVEF will award a special scholarship, to a graduating senior student either from DBHS or WHS or Alternative Education HS, in the amount of \$1,000 in the following category:

- ◆ Ron Hockwalt Educational Scholarship

During each academic year, WVEF will also award scholarships to WVUSD certificated and classified staff. The scholarships will be awarded as follows:

- ◆ One (1) scholarship of \$1,000 each to Certificated staff
- ◆ One (1) scholarship of \$1,000 each to Classified staff

To be considered for a scholarship award, WVUSD Principals, GLCs, or Management Officers must submit to WVEF the enclosed Scholarship Award Application. WVEF will review all applications in accordance with the established criteria and will finalize its selection(s) in each scholarship category.

**\*IMPORTANT: Applications must be RECEIVED no later than April 27, 2007. WVEF will only accept scholarship application requests received in this format and will announce the awards by May 18, 2007. **Visual and Performing Arts Scholarship Award**

- The student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- The student must be currently enrolled in the WVUSD for a minimum of three (3) years
- Scholarship Award Application must be duly completed by the applicant and signed by the GLC or Principal
- The student must have demonstrated exemplary performance in Fine Arts in one or more of the following areas --- Art, Dancing, Vocal or Instrumental music, Band, Drama, Film
- The key elements in the selection will include the GPA, accomplishments, recommendation, personal resume, and personal essay.

**Industrial Technology Scholarship Award**

- The student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- The student must be currently enrolled in the WVUSD for a minimum of three (3) years
- Scholarship Award Application must be duly completed by the applicant and signed by the GLC or Principal
- The accomplishments in Industrial Technology must be in one or more of the following areas --- Drafting, Technology, Advanced Technology, Publications, Business, Automotive, CAD/CAM, Graphic Design
- The key elements in the selection will include the GPA, accomplishments, recommendation, personal resume, and personal essay.

**Teen Citizen Scholarship Award**

- The student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- The student must be currently enrolled in the WVUSD for a minimum of three (3) years
- Scholarship Award Application must be duly completed by the applicant and signed by the GLC or Principal
- The student must have demonstrated exemplary citizenship, active participation, and accomplishments in a high school organization(s)
- The student must have demonstrated exemplary citizenship, active participation, and accomplishments in a local community organization(s)
- The key elements in the selection will include the length and level/type of participation in the organization(s), the GPA, accomplishments, recommendation, personal resume, and personal essay.

- The student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- The student must be currently enrolled in the WVUSD for a minimum of three (3) years
- Scholarship Award Application must be duly completed by the applicant and signed by the GLC or Principal
- The student must have demonstrated active participation, tutoring, or mentorship in the educational field during the high school or in a local community organization(s)
- The key elements in the selection will include the length of participation, tutoring, and level/type of mentorship in the educational field, the GPA, accomplishments, recommendation, personal resume, and personal essay.

**Staff Scholarship Award**

- The staff member must be currently employed with the WVUSD for a minimum of three years
- Scholarship Award Application must be duly completed by the applicant and signed by the school Principal or Management Officer
- The staff must have demonstrated exemplary performance, and interpersonal & problem solving skills in their day-to-day work environment
- The staff must have demonstrated active participation, and accomplishments in a WVUSD or local community organization(s)
- The key elements in the selection will include the interpersonal & problem solving skills, level/type of participation in the organization(s), the resume and the essay.
