Tuition Assistance Policy

Tuition assistance is a blessing to our students and families and is intended to help make Christian education available to more families. To help us in administering the tuition assistance program, the following guidelines are in place.

Eligibility

All families are eligible to apply for tuition assistance through FACTS. Information that is received remains confidential.

Assistance Round 1 Guidelines: Enrollment deadlines and requirements in order to be considered for a maximum of 50% tuition assistance based on the determined qualified need:

- April 15th deadline *
 - o FACTS application is complete including all supporting documentation.
 - Online enrollment is complete (including the registration fee) or will be completed within 2
 weeks of receiving the awarded tuition assistance.
 - All tuition and fees for the current school year are up-to-date.

Assistance Round 2 Guidelines: Enrollment deadlines and requirements in order to be considered for a maximum of 35% tuition assistance based on the determined qualified need:

- June 1st deadline
 - o FACTS application is complete including all supporting documentation.
 - Online enrollment is complete (including the registration fee) or will be completed within 2
 weeks of receiving the awarded tuition assistance.
 - o All tuition and fees for the current school year are up-to-date.

Assistance Round 3 Guidelines: Enrollment deadlines and requirements in order to be considered for a maximum of 20% tuition assistance based on the determined qualified need:

- Any time after the June 1st deadline
 - o FACTS application is complete including all supporting documentation.
 - Online enrollment is complete (including the registration fee) or will be completed within 2 weeks of receiving the awarded tuition assistance.
 - All tuition and fees for the current school year are up-to-date.
 - Funding of tuition assistance is available on a first-come, first-served basis until funding is exhausted.

^{*}New families applying for the school after the April 15th deadline *may* be considered at the Round 1 level of awards as long as their online enrollment is complete (including the registration fee) within 2 weeks of receiving the awarded tuition assistance.
