Spotlight on Carlisle High School

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SET TO RECOGNIZE CHS WITH "BREAKING BARRIERS" AWARD

Carlisle School district is proud to announce that the Iowa Department of Education will recognize Carlisle High School with the Breaking Barriers to Teaching and Learning Award. The Breaking Barriers to Teaching and Learning Award was created by the State Board of Education. Each year, the award recognizes successful efforts to eliminate achievement gaps. Reducing the achievement gap is one of the district's top priorities. CHS is being recognized for having 98% of Hispanic students proficient or above on Iowa Assessments for three consecutive school years. The state average during this time period was 64%.

Mr. Jim Flansberg, Communication Consultant for the Department of Education, notified the district of this exciting news this past week. Mr. Flansberg stated, "This is a tremendous honor that Carlisle High School should be very proud of." Mr. Blackmore, Principal at CHS, stated, "Our staff is committed to our mission, vision and goals of character, service and excellence in everything we do. Our district wide systemness around teacher collaboration and best practices has allowed us to have great successes with the wide variety of students that make up CHS." CHS teachers and staff use data as a driving force to change instructional practices. We have built in classroom interventions, and provide all students with clear and consistent feedback on their learning.

High School administrators along with district officials and CHS students, will accept the award at the State Capitol on January 25, 2018, in conjunction with a statewide luncheon celebration.

Carlisle Schools Food Pantry



Just a reminder the Carlisle Schools Food Pantry is open to the public on the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of the month from 4:00 p.m.—6:00 p.m. at the West entrance of the High School building in Room 106. (The doors between the Elementary and High School). Please do not arrive before 3:40 p.m. to allow our students and buses to safely exit the facility.

This new location allows us to have more food on hand during our open times to serve more families. Students who attend Carlisle Schools have access to the food pantry every day that school is in session. If a student or family is in need they should see their school counselor in the building for assistance. Hartford Upper Elementary and Carlisle Middle School also have a mini pantry to help students and families at any time.

If you are unable to make it to the Food Pantry during the open times, you can contact the High School Office to set up an appointment (515-989-5389).
