PUBLIC NOTICE OF STORMWATER POLLUTION PREVENTION INITIATIVE AND DISTRICT POLLUTION PREVENTION PLAN

The Allen Park Public Schools (APPS) has submitted and received approval of the “APPS Stormwater Pollution Prevention Initiative (SWPPI) and the District Pollution Prevention Plan (DPPP)” from the City of Allen Park as required under the NPDES General Permit and nesting agreement with City of Allen Park.

The SWPPI and DPPP have been developed by APPS to address the requirements of the Watershed General Permit, and to be in alignment with the City of Allen Park’s SWPPI, per the nesting agreement between the City of Allen Park and APPS. The plans identify the structural and non-structural controls to be implemented by the district to meet the six minimum measures. The six minimum measures include:

- Public Education Program (PEP)
- Illicit Discharge Elimination Program (IDEP)
- Public Involvement Plan (PIP)
- Pollution Prevention and Good Housekeeping (PPGH)
- Construction Site Runoff Control
- Post Construction Runoff Control

Each program describes policies, procedures, strategies, and measurable goals established by APPS to implement and monitor the on-going success of this program.
