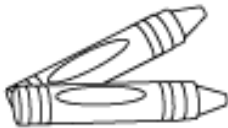

Look What We're Learning!

Our class has been working on identifying the difference between a letter and a word as well as identifying spaces between words. We have learned how to identify and write the uppercase "T" and the lowercase "t". We also learned the sound Tt makes. Please practice writing Tt at home. Next week, we will learn about Bb and Ff.

In math, we are working with the numbers 1-10. We are working on identifying, writing, and making sets for the numbers. Please help your child count to at least twenty.

We are also continuing to work on writing first and last names using correct capitalization.

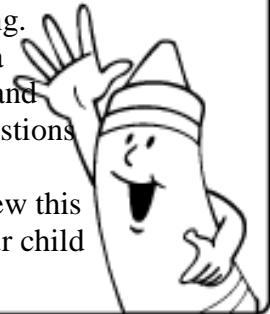


Upcoming Events:
