## CITY PROFILE

Medical Lake is a small community with a population of 4,990. Medical Lake is surrounded by several lakes and is located 16 miles southwest of Spokane and approximately 7 miles south of Fairchild Air Force Base. Several community parks are located on the Medical Lake waterfront, and the city boasts over 5 miles of paved trails for walking, jogging or bicycling.

## SCHOOL DISTRICT PROFILE

Medical Lake School District encompasses 80 square miles and serves the community of Medical Lake, its outlying areas, and Fairchild Air Force Base. There are 1,963 students enrolled in grades preschool through twelve grade in Medical Lake High School, Medical Lake Alternative High School, Medical Lake Middle School, Hallett Elementary School and Michael Anderson Elementary School. Forty six percent of the students are dependents of military personnel or have parents working on Fairchild Air Force Base.

Our JROTC program includes an award winning drill team. Medical Lake High School has an extensive fine arts program including music and drama.
