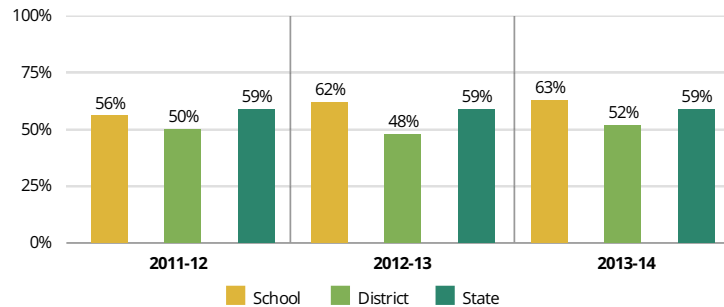
Academic Growth

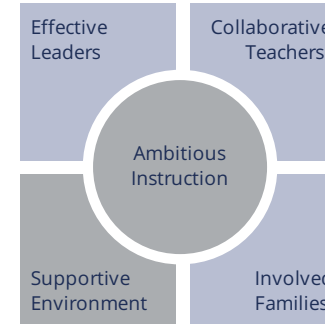

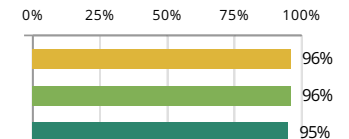

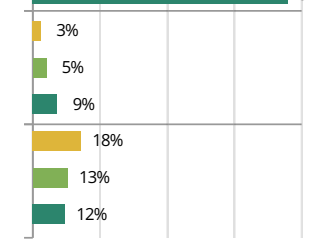
Attendance Rate

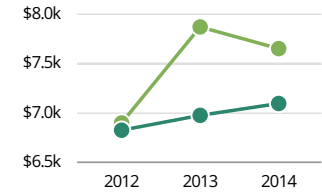

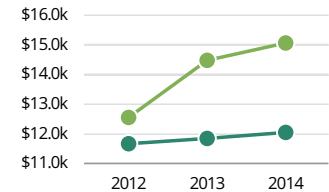
